ast ensington utdoor earning Program Registration for all new students (Kindergarten to grade 5) for next year begins on Monday January 14th at 8:00 am. Registration is on a first come, first served basis.

<u>Current families who have a child starting</u> <u>kindergarten in September of 2019 have</u> <u>priority registration during the week of</u> <u>January 7th to the 11th. After this date they</u> <u>will not have priority.</u>

The following original documents are required at the school when registering:

1. Proof of birth date for the student (birth certificate or passport);

2. Proof of guardianship (as shown on the child's birth certificate, or other appropriate legal documentation such as landed immigrant document or guardianship order);

3. Proof of citizenship for both the parent and student (Canadian birth certificate, citizenship card, passport, landed immigrant document, permanent resident card, enhanced driver's license or enhanced identification card);

4. Proof of residence (e.g., ordinarily resident) of parent/guardian in B.C.:

a. BC driver's license, BC Services Card, BCID or BC Care Card of parent/legal guardian; or

b. A combination of other supporting documentation such as ownership/long-term lease of dwelling, vehicle registration, employment records, Canadian income tax record, etc.

5. Proof of living address (purchase or rental agreement, utility bill, driver's license, etc.).

Documents which are helpful, but not required to register:

• Health documents (BC Care Card, immunization records, medical condition information);

• Educational background (report cards).
