certificate or appropriate legal documentation), Proof of Citizenship for both parents (Canadian Birth Certificate, Citizenship card, Canadian Passport, Landed Immigrant Document, Permanent Resident Card), and proof of living address (purchase or rental agreement, utility bill). Documents that are helpful, but not required are health documents (care card, immunization records).
