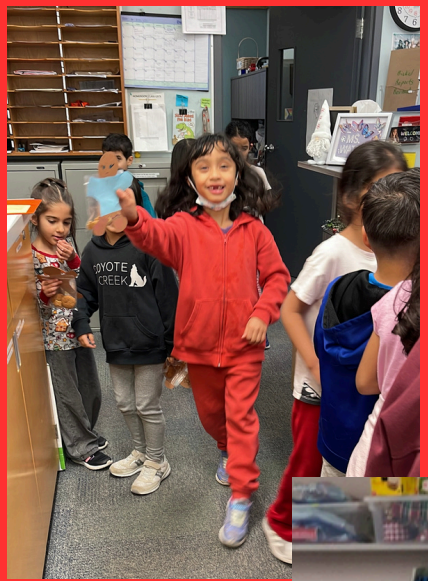

It's a simple way to contribute to the arts at Coyote Creek while clearing out some space in your home.

## How You Can Help

It's easy! Here's what you can do:

- 1. Collect Your Empty Beverage Containers** - Gather any empty bottles, cans, or other beverage containers that you no longer need.
- 2. Drop Off Your Bags** - Between Dec. 16-20 and Jan. 6-10, drop off your containers at the Express Drop Off area at the Fleetwood Bottle Depot.
- 3. Label Your Bags:**
  - o At the Express Drop Off, use Ms. Fontana's phone number (604-375-2213) at the kiosk to log in and print labels for your bags.
  - o Don't forget to label each of your bags before you drop them off!

## Bag Requirements

Put your empty beverage containers into clear or transparent plastic bags (up to 90 litres in size).

### No sorting needed!

If you need plastic bags, stop by Ms. Fontana's outside door (Room 401, in front of the large playground) anytime from Dec. 16-20 or Jan. 6-10 during school hours to pick up bags.

By donating your empty beverage containers, you are directly helping fund the Young Actors Program, which will provide a valuable and engaging arts experience for our Grade 3 students. This is a fantastic opportunity to enrich students education and foster a love for the arts, all thanks to your generous support.
