



District Authority Scholarship Instructions (Grads of 2026)

Online submission from February 18 - April 28, 2026.

District Authority Scholarship applications are due on April 28 by 4 PM. Late applications will not be accepted. DISTRICT AUTHORITY scholarships are each valued at \$1250: Take the time to read through the application in advance.

You may apply for more than one district authority scholarship (for example Dance and Modern Languages), but each requires a separate application. A student can only win ONE district authority scholarship.

For each district authority scholarship, the student must submit a portfolio (google slides or office365 PowerPoint or video) as part of the application process. This is to demonstrate your excellence in the area in which you are applying.
