

Dual credit and High School on Campus Courses

Students receive credit for post-secondary courses while, at the same time, earning high school credit towards their graduation with the 5 dual credit options below. Kwantlen Polytechnic University, Douglas College, Simon Fraser University, and Nicola Valley Institute of Technology provide Surrey School District students with the opportunity to take post-secondary courses, tuition-free, while they are still in high school.



Community & Public Safety

- Tuesday evenings at Queen Elizabeth Secondary; Course runs September to December
- Students must be in grade 12 while taking the course
- Recommended “C+” or better in Math 10 & English Language Arts 10
- Applicants must have a strong interest in pursuing a career in community and public safety



DOUGLAS COLLEGE

Child & Youth Care Counsellor

- Course runs July – August at Princess Margaret Secondary
- Successful completion of grade 11
- Require this course with the intention to pursue a career as a Child & Youth Care Counsellor
- Capable of academic rigor



Legal Office Procedures

- Course located at KPU's Surrey campus; Course runs July - August
- Successful completion of English Language Arts 10 with a minimum of a “C”
- Students must have successfully completed grade 11 prior to starting the course
- Good communication skills, strong organizational skills and exceptional professionalism
- Interest in pursuing a career as a legal office assistant or a paralegal professional

Graphic Design

- Course located at Simon Fraser University Surrey campus
- Course runs September to December with a combination of online & in person learning
- Successful completion of English Language Arts 10 & Math 10 with a minimum of a “C+”
- Students must have successfully completed grade 10 prior to starting the course
- Students should have the intention to pursue a career in graphic design or digital media arts
- Students will be expected to put in time outside of class to learn required software and to work on projects



Health Science

- Course is located at KPU's Surrey campus
- Course runs from July - August
- Successful completion of grade 11 is required prior to starting the course
- English Language Arts 10 & Math 10 with a minimum of a “C+”
- Students should have the intention of pursuing a career as a nurse

Delivered in partnership with Kwantlen Polytechnic University (KPU), High School on Campus (HSOC) provides students in grades 11 and 12 with an opportunity to complete a post-secondary course TUITION-FREE. HSOC courses are taught by KPU instructors and delivered onsite at KPU. A list of course offerings and the HSOC application package is shared with schools twice each school year. Applications for the fall term are available in early April and applications for the spring term are available in early October. Examples of past courses include options in Marketing, Accounting, Business Mathematics, and Psychology.
