## **PHOTOGRAPHY**

Artona will be on site to take a photo of each graduate as they cross the stage. Families will be provided a professional digital photo of their graduate crossing the stage in their cap and gown with their diploma folder. Due to COVID number restrictions and timing we will not be able to accommodate:

- families leaving their vehicle to take photographs.
- students having a photo taken in their formal attire (gowns and suits).

## **GUESTS**

- In order to adhere to Provincial Health Guidelines each student/family will be allowed to have <u>ONE</u> vehicle on site.
  Each student <u>must</u> arrive in this vehicle along with their guest(s). A graduate in their cap and gown will be the vehicle's entry into the event.
- As this event is being recorded, we need to stress that we cannot have car horns, air horns or other noise makers occurring during the ceremony. If this happens, the video company will need to edit and remove those students' 'crossing' from the final product.
- There will be no access to the building before or after the ceremony, which means there are no available washrooms for use on site.
