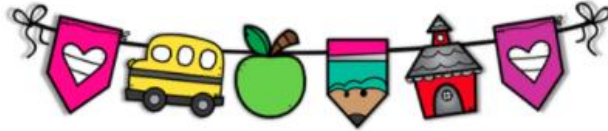


Kindergarten Registration
