Science Fair

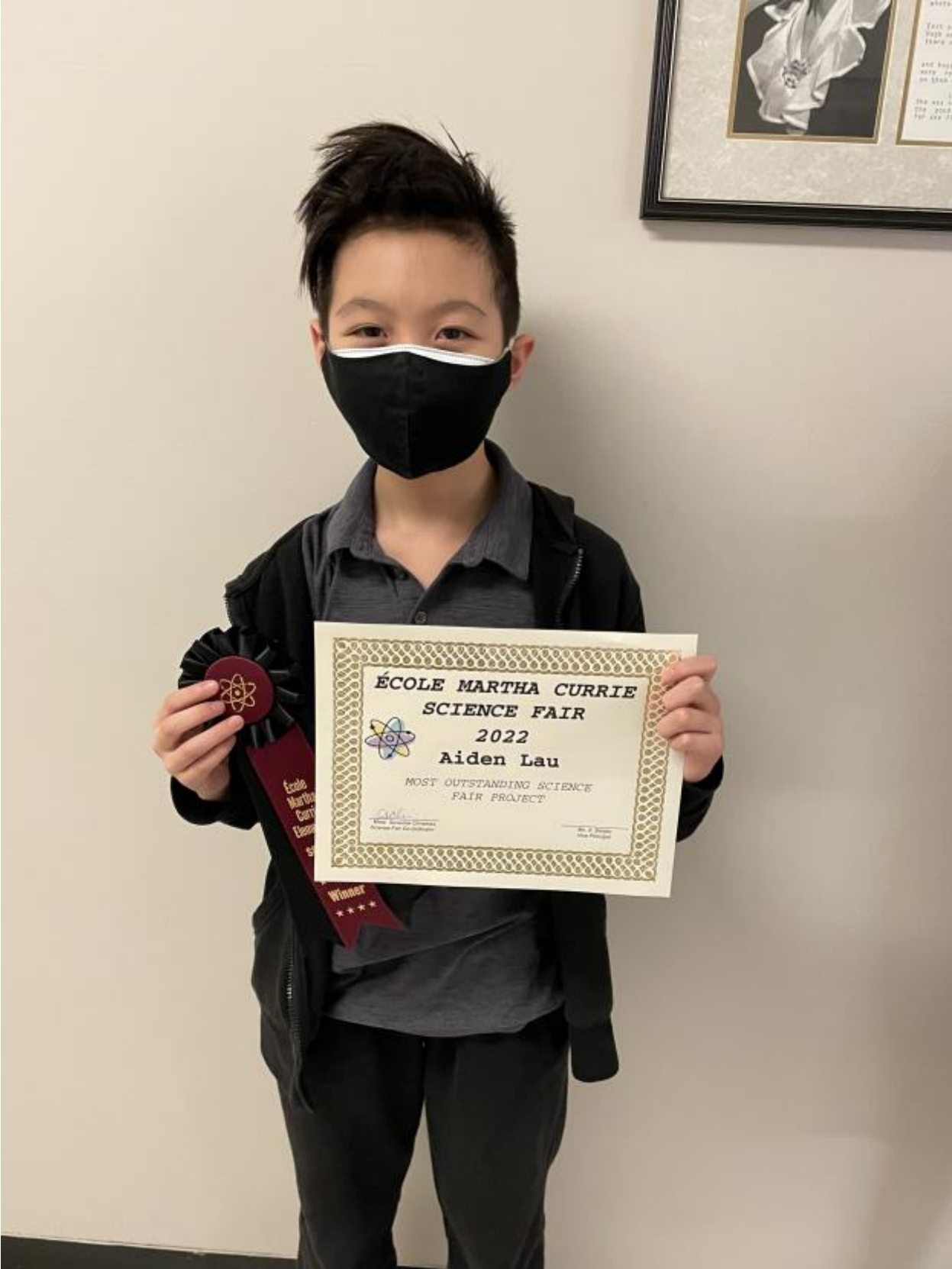

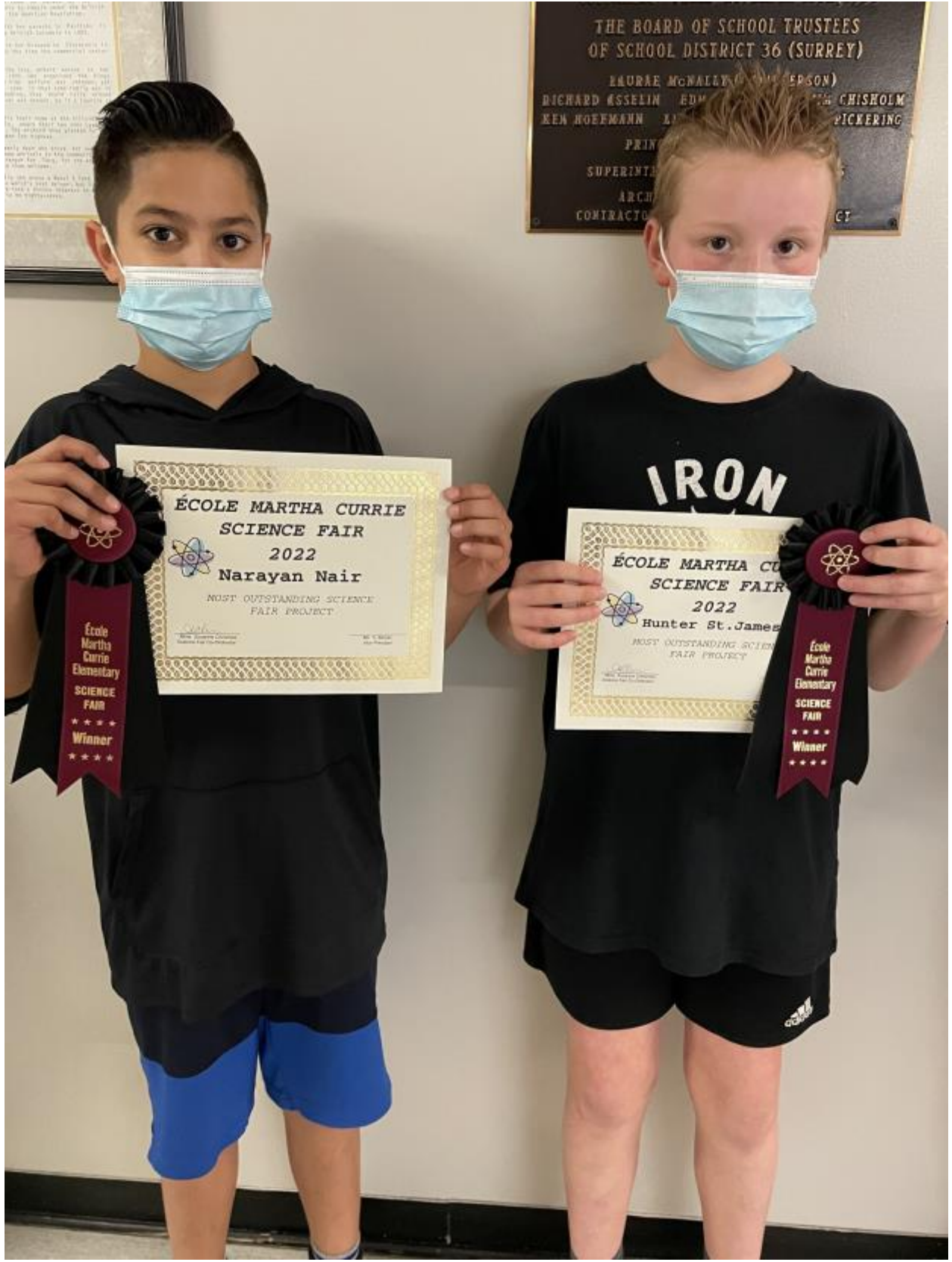

Daily Health Check

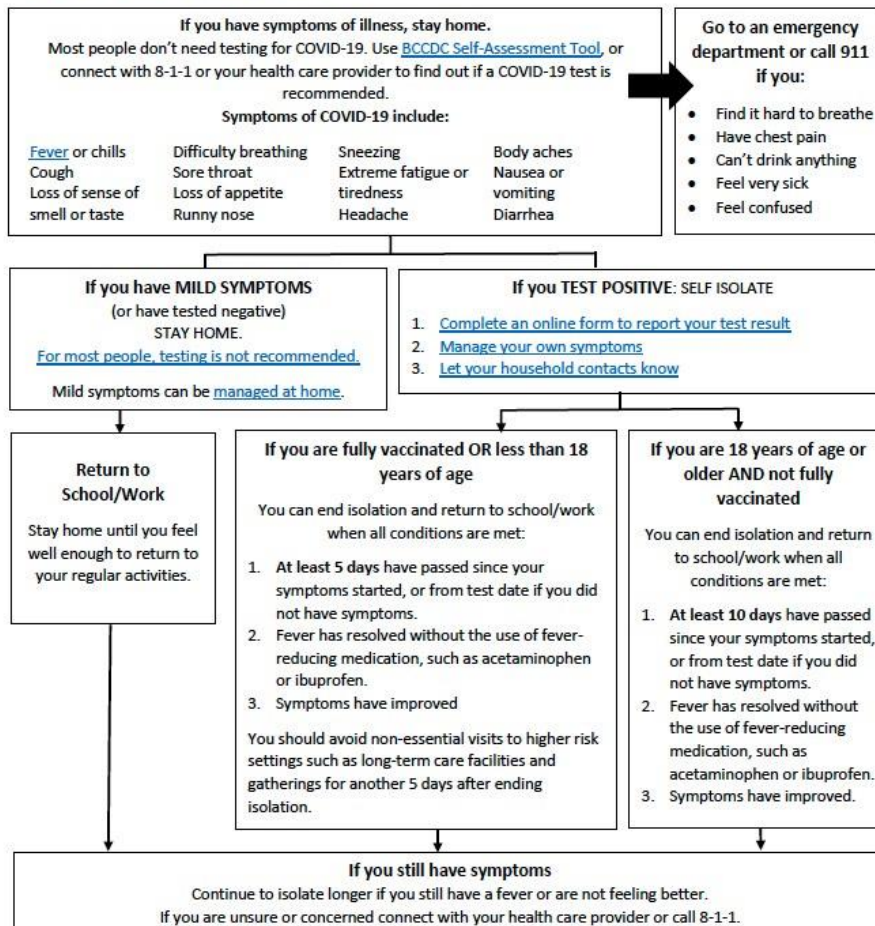


If you are unsure about sending your child to school, please do the online health check at <https://www.k12dailycheck.gov.bc.ca/healthcheck?execution=e1s1>.

If your child will be away from school for any reason, please be sure to contact the school office at 604-576-8551 to let us know. Voicemail is available for you to leave a message outside of regular school hours. Please be sure to clearly state your child's first and last name, grade and/or teacher, and the reason they will be away from school. We appreciate your help and support with this.

Summary: What to Do When Sick



What to do if someone is sick in your household:

You can continue to attend school if someone in your household is sick and/or self-isolating as long as you do not have any symptoms of illness and feel well. This includes if they have tested positive for COVID-19. Ensure you closely monitor yourself (or your child) for symptoms of illness and stay home if you feel unwell. The best way to protect yourself and your family from COVID-19 is to get vaccinated. Vaccines are available for anyone ages 5 and up.
