  - Physical distancing 2m apart outside of cohort
- Enrollment
  - Projected for 1318 but currently have 1375
  - 50 International students were unable to attend
  - o Many students in SAIL or Transitions program

  - Support programs for Grade 8 LST, Bases, POD, HOPE, Counselling
  - Gaming grants process with PAC and staff
