72 Hours: Is Your Family Prepared?

If an emergency or natural disaster happens in our community (earthquake, fire, flood,

power outage, snow storm, etc.), there is likely to be a lot of chaos and confusion in the

following days. All homes should be prepared to be self-sufficient for at least 72 hours

(3 days). A readily-available **emergency kit** is an important part of this preparation.

To help our families be prepared, Latimer Road PAC has partnered with **BCQuake.ca**

to arrange a discount on survival kits. The primary purpose of this campaign is to

ensure that each home is prepared for a disaster, although the PAC will also receive a

portion of each kit sold (\$20 for each home kit and \$10 for each vehicle kit).

ReadyGo Survival Kits (sizes for 1 to 4 people) are packed into backpacks for

easy portability. These can be stored at home or in your vehicle in case you

happen to be away from home when a disaster strikes.

• Premium Survival Kits (sizes for 1 to 6 people) include additional survival items

such as a portable stove and fuel.

Vehicle Survival Kits are not 72-hour kits, but will ensure you are prepared for a

variety of emergencies while away from home.
