- EMS PAC Bank Accounts consist of 3 separate accounts, to ensure full transparency and ease of management
 - 1. Gaming Account Gaming has specific rules and restrictions
 - 2. Admin Account- General inflows through donations and/or district payments
 - 3. Dry Grad Account PAC manages to help manage and control the funds for transparency

EMS PAC Account Balances as @ February 26th, 2024:

- Admin Account \$ 22,481.35
 - 1. \$5,000 set aside for the 50 Year celebration, only one cheque for \$500 to date.
 - 2. Received approx. \$6000 in parent donations.

• Dry Grad Account Bank Balance \$ 31,172.79 *

- 1. Cheques outstanding = \$1,259.89 *Updated Balance = \$29,912.90
- 2. Funds to be allocated: \$2000 to Legacy Gift from Grad 2023 for mural.
- 3. \$7,213.91 To remain in account consisting of seed funds and previouss grad class contributions donated to specific future classes.
- 4. Payments to date = \$ 16,144.44
- 5. Current account balance available \$20,698.99 to Grad 2024.

• Gaming Account \$46,635.38

1. \$734.80 net dispersed for period, - various school club expenses – approved budgeted funds.

EMS General Account – School Fundraising \$1,586.85

- General account for school fundraising (PowWow and 50th year celebration events). Funds are returned to school for program activities Community account, therefore no fees for these accounts.
- 2. \$1,085 received to date from Square from the 50th Anniversary event at the school
- Additional notes:
 - 1. Budget request submission will be sent out in May.
 - 2. Gaming unspent amounts advised most teachers of remaining balances.
 - 3. Admin asks, can we utilize the Square at other fundraisers (teams/clubs)? Will confirm.
