- The successful Fall Athletic season has wrapped up, ending with a well attended Fall Athletic banquet.
- Winter sports have started up including basketball, wresting, curling and a new EMS dance team has started practices. EMS hosted a boys basketball tournament in December. And our curling and wrestling teams are heading to upcoming competitions.
- Hosted One Act Plays in December as well as two winter band concerts.
- Academic semester ended today. Students coming in for additional academic work over the next two days.
- At EMS, near the end of the first 6 to 8 weeks of term, an interim report is generated. The Ministry has reduced the reporting requirements for the interim report. Now it is called a learning update. Schools have been given flexibility on what the interim report looks like. What information would EMS parents like to see on the report? Would phone calls/emails/checklists be helpful? Would like to see parent feedback.
 - Parent round table answer student specific, general student performance.
 - Possible that maybe teachers reach out to parents of students who may need meetings.
 - This Spring, we may get emails, a handout/checklist, designated phone call (school will let us know if this would happen) for the interim report card.
 - Mr Magnusson notes that language does not need to be a barrier, Surrey Schools has a multi-cultural team that helps with communications.

 - Closing Balance \$15,800.62

- Must keep \$2000 in the bank as seed money each year.
- Available to this years grad from Prior year contributions -= \$3,546.15 (details below)
 - o Grad 2022 donation \$1,878.39
 - o Grad 2020 donation \$1,667.76
 - Increase in funds due to two fundraisers (Pasta Night & Purdy's)
- Heads up that there will be an Easter Purdy's fundraiser
- Will use Grad 2023 legacy gift towards repair of the mural in the main entrance
- Used the final remainder of Grad 2023 fund to purchase a square of the PAC
- Gaming Account Bank balance \$27,452.83
 - \$15,356 paid out in approved budget requests, such as Latin Funk, Athletics, 3 Crows Production, club supplies. Three outstanding cheques.
 - Closing Balance \$25,403.83
