- Held 1<sup>st</sup> PAC Meeting
  - New Principal opened meeting– many question related to start-up.
  - Elections held and appointed positions
  - Expect another meeting to offer members at large
  - Callout for support to feeder schools to provide funding from Gaming Funds that feeder schools received for the students transferring to Grandview. Formal request is expected to be made in September
  - Expect approximately 1100 students on opening

  - Explained the EMS House Posts, significance to great people and to manage energy – plan the cleansing/sweep of the house posts pre September school start-up. It was recommended that this take place in the last 2 weeks of August when school administration is back.
  - Reiterated the importance to not lose the continuity of the work that Michael MacKay-Dunn has been doing.
  - Next Pow Wow will be April 1-3<sup>rd</sup>
