Who plans Dry Grad?

- A group of parents and guardians form the Dry Grad committee.
- They raise money to support a safe, alcohol- and drug-free graduation party.
- The event takes place right after the Grad Dinner and Dance.
- Parents lead everything they organize, run, and supervise the event.

What is Dry Grad?

- It's an all-night party just for graduating grade 12 students.
- No alcohol, drugs, or tobacco are allowed—completely "dry."
- The party starts after the dinner and dance, lasting until early morning (typically 3 5 AM)
- Inside, students enjoy food, drinks, music, games, entertainment, and fun activities photo booths, games and prizes!

Why do a Dry Grad?

- To give grads a fun, safe place to celebrate graduation without risks.
- It helps prevent accidents or unsafe choices on a big night for teens.

Important Rules & Steps

- Buy tickets in advance online (e.g., through School Cash Online) or at the school office.
- Sign a permission waiver every student must complete it before buying a ticket.
- Follow event rules once students arrive, they stay inside until the event ends.
- Parent volunteers' chaperone and support they help watch, serve food, run activities, and make the night safe and fun.
