Weapons and Violence Policy:

- The Board has adopted a position of zero tolerance for aggression, violence or threat of violence in schools. Schools will investigate and apply discipline, as appropriate. The RCMP may be involved.
- Violence includes the actual or threatened use of physical, verbal or emotional power, by or against individuals or groups which results in physical and/or psychological harm, or is harmful to the social well-being of an individual or group of individuals.
- All persons who arm themselves with weapons, replica weapons or potential weapons will be dealt with. School discipline will apply and the RCMP may be involved.
- A weapon is any instrument designed to inflict injury or intimidate another person, or any instrument that is used in this manner. A replica weapon is any facsimile of an authentic weapon, including toys. Potential weapons include laser pointers.
