

DISTRICT AUTHORITY SCHOLARSHIPS - \$1,250

The Ministry of Education designs these awards to acknowledge excellence in fields other than academics. Awards are given to students who have excelled in the following areas:

- Indigenous Languages and Culture
- Fine Arts (Visual Art, Dance, Drama, Music)
- Applied Skills (Business Education, Tech Education, Home Economics)
- Physical Activity (Athletics, Dance, Gymnastics)
- Second Languages (French and Spanish)
- Community Service (volunteering in school and in the community)
- Technical & Trades Training (Carpentry, Automotive, Cafeteria etc.)

DISTRICT AUTHORITY SCHOLARSHIPS - \$1,250

Applications are available via the NS Scholarship Updates Team, in the format of a fillable form.



NSS In-School Scholarships \$250-\$1500

NSS In-School Scholarships are donated to North Surrey Secondary from a variety of community donors.

They range in value from \$250 to \$1,500.

You are able to apply to all NSS In-School Scholarships on the same form.

Sample Application Form

NSS In-School & District Authority SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Completed applications must be submitted by April 15th, before 4:00 pm. Late applications will not be reviewed.

All graduation requirements must be fulfilled by August 31st of graduating year.

Award winners will be announced during the Commencement ceremony.

International students are not eligible to apply. If you have any questions, please come to the Career Centre.

How to apply for both types of scholarships on the same form:

- 16. This form allows you to apply for both NSS In-School Scholarships and District Authority Scholarships. Select the type of scholarship you wish to apply for:
 - I am applying for District Authority Scholarships & NSS In-School Scholarships (essay required)
 - I am applying for a District Authority Scholarship ONLY (no essay required)
 - I am applying for NSS In-School Scholarships ONLY (essay required)

District Authority Scholarship Categories

On the application you will see the following categories. Please only select and fill in the ones that are applicable to you.

In the box below provide:

- 1. Name of the course & teacher
- 2. Briefly describe how you have demonstrated outstanding achievement in the area indicated above. Be specific and consider: Character / Service / Leadership, etc.

APPLIED SKILLS (eg. Business, Technology, Home Economics, Information Communication Technology).

community Service - Volunteer Activity (Includes awareness of local, global, and cultural issues, demonstrated at school or in the community) - for out-of-school involvement, you must provide a Community Reference. Email (baig_a@surreyschools.ca) or hand in your Community Reference to Ms. Baig in the Career Centre.

SECOND LANGUAGES (French or Spanish taken at NSS)

FINE ARTS (eg. Visual Arts, Dance, Drama, Music)

INDIGINOUS LANGUAGES AND CULTURE (Demonstrated at school or in the community) - for out-of-school involvement, you must provide a Community Reference. Email (baig_a@surreyschools.ca) or hand in your Community Reference to Ms. Baig in the Career Centre.

PHYSICAL ACTIVITY (eg. Athletics, Dance, Gymnastics, not limited to Physical Education)

TECHNICAL AND TRADES TRAINING (eg. Automotive, Robotics, Coding, Woodwork, Culinary Arts)

Examples of NSS In-School Scholarship Application Questions

On your application you only need to answer questions that are applicable to you.

LIST ANY EMPLOYMENT / WORK EXPERIENCE YOU HAVE. Start with your most recent job first. Provide the name of the employer, when you started and how long you worked there (or if you're still working there), your job title, and a short description of your duties and job responsibilities - leave blank if not applicable to you.

- List any School involvement you have (clubs, sports, committees, etc.) and your role in each
- Start with your most recent involvement. Provide the name of the committee, how long you've been involved and your role in each leave blank if not applicable to you.
- List any In-School volunteering you have
- List any Out-of-School volunteering you have
- List your athletic involvement (sports, programs, teams, activities, etc.)
- List any academic awards you may have received during your high school years (certificates, academic competitions, medals, top student, special programs you have attended such as SHAD, etc.)
- List any other achievements you may have (such as Royal Conservatory piano, dance, back belt, etc.)

Scholarship Essay Question
