Principal Report - Fiona Ekhert

Thank you for supporting the kids basketball. We can't do it without parent support. We are looking forward to Ultimate, Badminton and Minecraft Challenge group. The Reading Link Challenge is coming up on March 4. There will be a Musical concert on March 5 with the band and the choir, two performances, 9:00AM and 1:00PM.

The 10 new iPads with keyboards came in. Positive feedback from the primary kids. For cost effectiveness, this is the way to go (1/3 of the cost of a computer). We are good for tech this year.

The cost of putting on the play is \$13,000, most of it for hardware. A short-throw projector with the screen saves the cost of doing background scenery.

Discussion had regarding the converting the previous \$5000 loan transfer PAC made into a gift, for efficiencies sake and planning/budgeting for musical production

equipment. All of the profits from current and upcoming fundraisers slated for the musical (ie: Purdy's, Spring Dance) can be used to recoup gift to the school. Vote to recoup loan for Musical Production Equipment expenses through upcoming fundraisers instead of waiting for ticket sales.
