## School Fees Information for 2021-2022

Each school year, parents support their child(ren)'s formal lea ming experiences in a wide variety of ways. We appreciate all that you do to ensure a successful year.

In addition to providing the school supplies itemized on a grade list, parents are periodic ally asked formonies to cover specific items and/orspecial events. As we plan for the upcoming school year, we antic ipate the following costs:

Student Planner: We encourage all students in Grades 1-7 to purchase a School Planner at a cost of $\$ 5.00$. Included in the planner is our school code of conduct, school calendar and school district information. We find this to be an excellent tool for facilitating home/school communic ation, as well as for developing our students' organiza tional skills. However, using our sc hool planner is optional.

Field Studies and Field Tips: C lasses often enjoy ed uc ational visits to community fac ilities which extend and enhance the curic ulum. While we use school monies or fundraise to cover the costs of such a c tivities wherever possible, there are times when parents a re a sked to contribute towards the cost of the trip. If you choose to have your child not partic ipate in a field study, a suitable program will be provided at the school.

Musical Instruments: Grade 4 students may leam to play the recorder. Students will have the option of purchasing one through the school or receiving one on loan from the school. The cost of the recorders will be known at the beginning of the school year. Also, our Grade 7 students who choose to take band either purchase or rent an instrument. Costs vary depending on the instrument.

School Supplies: For students in Grades 1-3, pa rents have the option of purchasing their child's school supplies on their own utilizing the grade supply list or for your convenience you may wish to purchase supplies from Edupac. Payment of these supplies from Edupac will be made to your child's teacher in September. Cost for supplies will be $\$ 40$. For students in Grades 4-7 they will be given a supply list for items needed in September. The cost should not exceed $\$ 60$. Please look through your current supplies to see what can be reused for the coming school year.

Kindergarten: parents have the option of purc hasing their child'sschool supplies on their own utilizing the grade supply list posted on our website or purchasing through the school a one-time fee of $\$ 40.00$ for supplies. This c ost will cover supplies.

Be assured we will be sensitive to your needs a nd no student at BeaverCreek will be denied an opportunity to partic ipate in any activity or receive the necessary school item through an inability to pay. Please let your child(ren)'s tea cher or Ms. Anderson know if any of these fees present a financial hardship.
