

Dear Parent / Guardian,

On April 30<sup>th</sup>, we shared some information with you about an <u>RCMP news release</u> about two incidents that occurred in the Fleetwood area. The first incident involved a report of an indecent act that took place on April 29, while the second involves a report of a suspicious circumstance on April 18.

Since the initial media release four more victims have come forward and provided information to police regarding three additional incidents.

RCMP issued a <u>news release today</u> and renewed their appeal for information and shared two composite sketches.

We wanted to ensure our school communities are aware of these incidents and once again share some personal safety tips to discuss with your children:

- Do not take short cuts. Use main routes and avoid secluded areas.
- Walk with others when possible.
- Tell someone where you are going and when you will be back.
- Phone home when leaving a friend's house and say when you will be home.
- Trust your instincts and your feelings.
- Phone if you are going to be delayed, or if your plans change
- If you believe, you are being followed call 911.
