Mrs. Mann's Kindergarten students are learning about community, our grade 2 classes are learning about how our actions affect the environment as Earth Day approaches and Mr. Thornton's class will be building toy cars to help learn the principles of physics. These are just some examples of the fantastic learning that is happening here at Frost Road. All students are working on a school-wide art project that our wonderful art committee has planned. The mural will be up in our halls the first week of May for all of us in the school to enjoy. Thank you to all of you for completing the Daily Health Check each day with your child. We are all working together to ensure our Frost Road family stays safe and healthy.

As you know on March 27, the Provincial Health Officer released an order, mandating mask use for all grade 4 to 7 students in the Surrey School District and is strongly encouraging all K-3 students to wear

masks. We are very proud of our grade 4-7 students and families for adjusting to this new order so quickly.

We would like to thank Fraser Health and the Surrey School District for the very successful roll out of the COVID vaccinations for staff. This is another step taken to ensure the safety of our students and staff.

As our weather starts to improve, we know people will want to stop and socialize or play on the playgrounds. However, a recent update to the Provincial COVID-19 Health and Safety Guidelines for K-12 Settings require that *“Parents/caregivers and other visitors should maintain physical distance and avoid crowding while on school grounds, including outside.”*

As per the district announcement, we ask that students and parents leave the school grounds and playground areas promptly after school. *Thank you for your cooperation and support limiting gatherings at this time.*

Another measure the Surrey School District is taking to keep our schools safe is to implement three early dismissal days. These early dismissal days are to provide an opportunity for school-based health & safety committees and school staff to review and revisit health & safety plans.

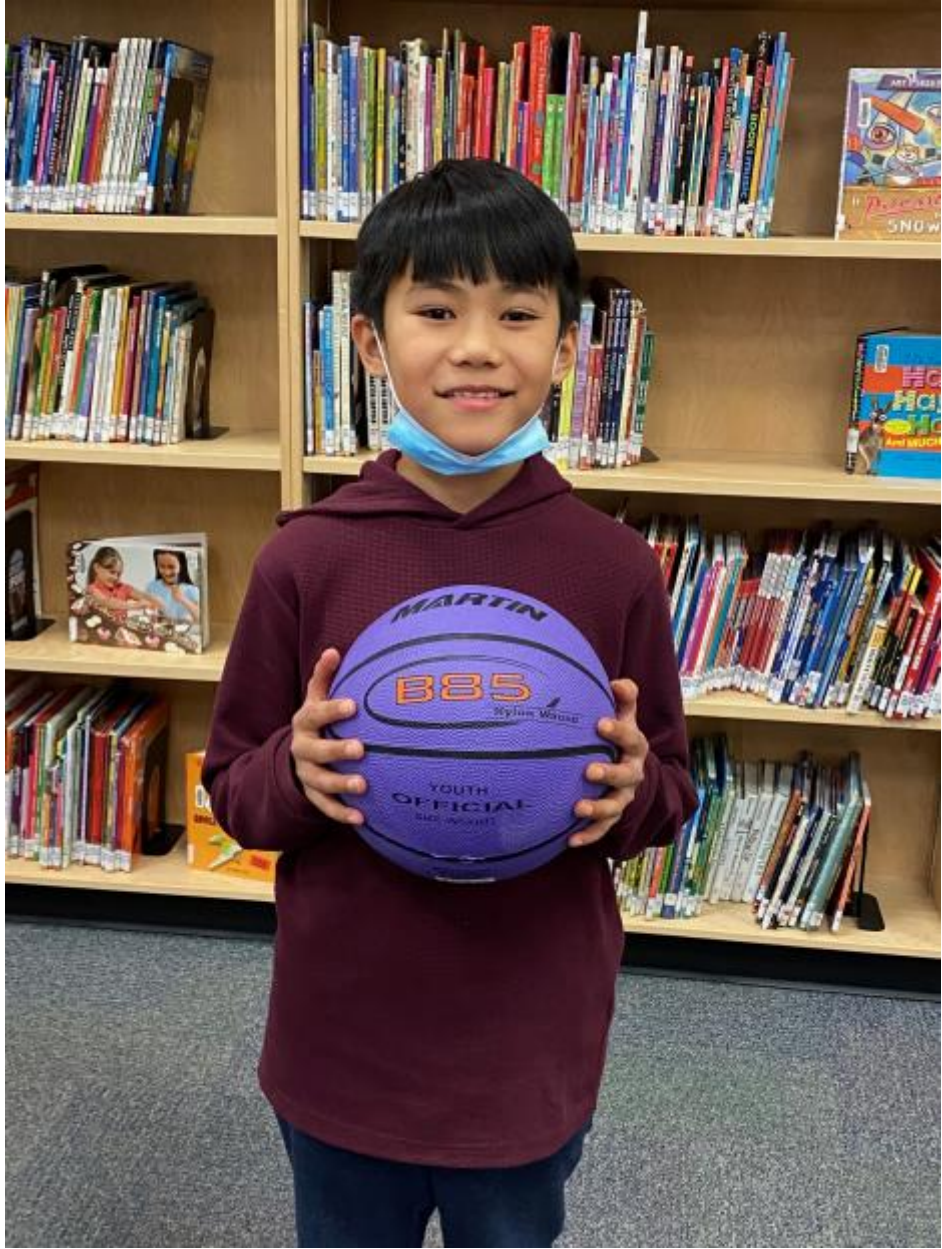


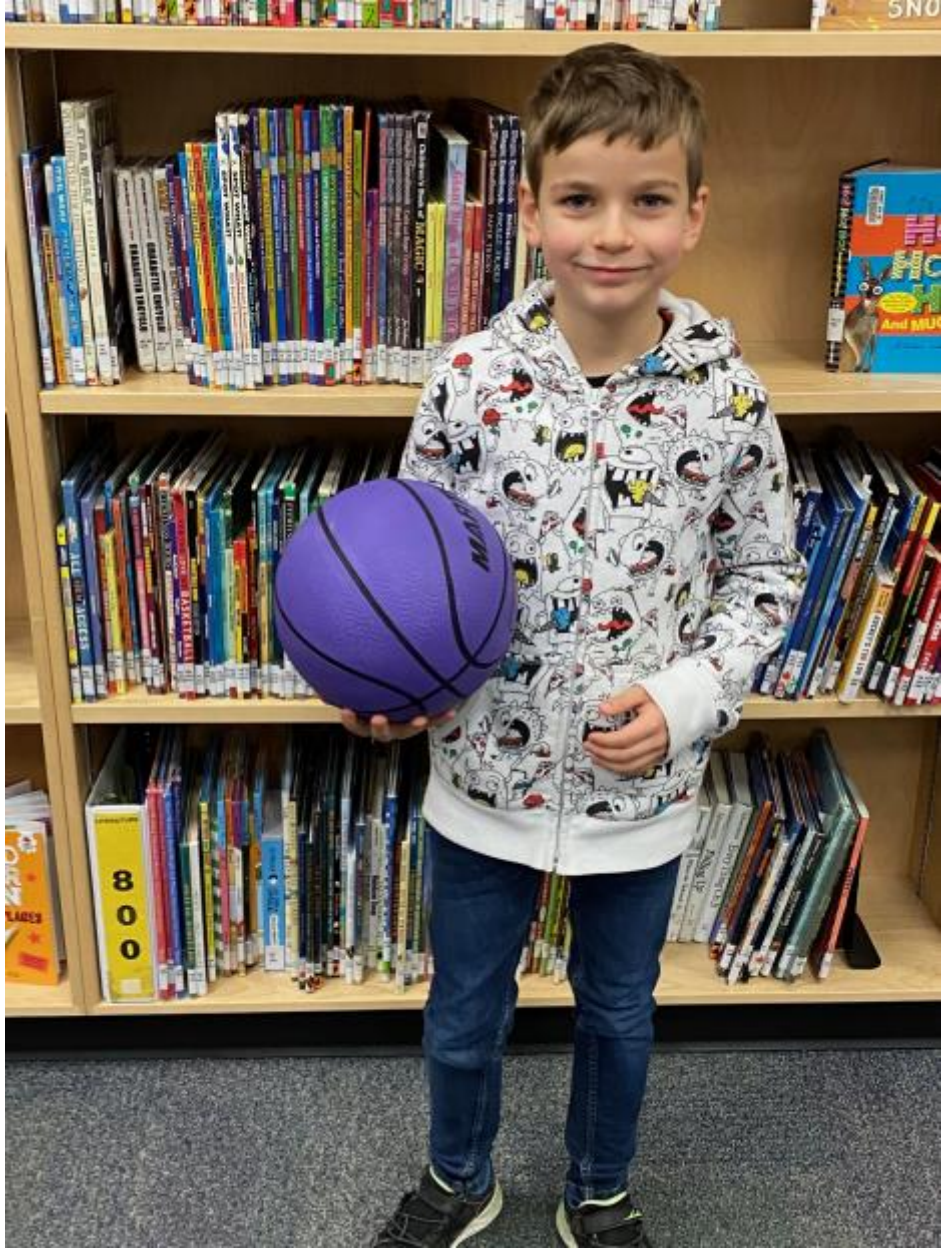

School Cash Online



Frost Road's preferred method of payment for such things as school fees, spirit wear, field trips, etc. is *School Cash Online*, which provides you with the convenience of paying online using:

Credit Card, Debit Card or eCheck (an electronic version of a paper check used to make payments online. Anyone with a

checking or savings account can pay by **eCheck** on SchoolCashOnline.

To register online:

Step 1: Visit our school website at: (**www.surreyschools.ca/frostroad**)

Step 2: Click on the "Parent" tab and select "Pay Fees Online".

Step 3: Register by selecting the "Get Started Now" and follow the steps.

Step 4: After you receive the confirmation email, select the "click here" option, **login in and add each of your children to your household account.**

Once you have registered your child, you will be able to see when they have a new item posted online for purchase. You also have the option to be notified whenever your child has a new school expense due, so you don't have to worry about missing the deadline.
