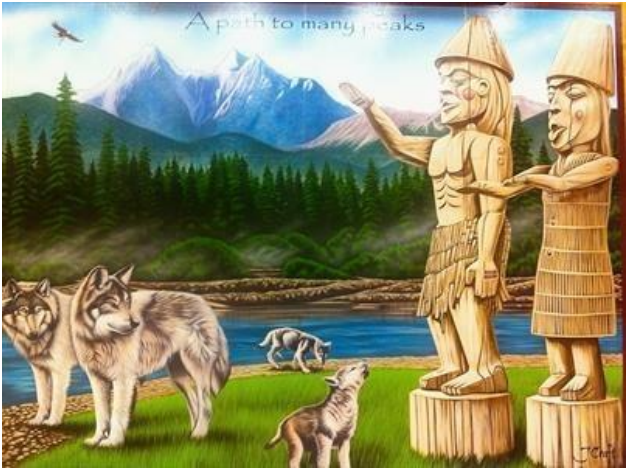

Thank you to Frost Road Staff Aboriginal Committee for putting together the student's artwork







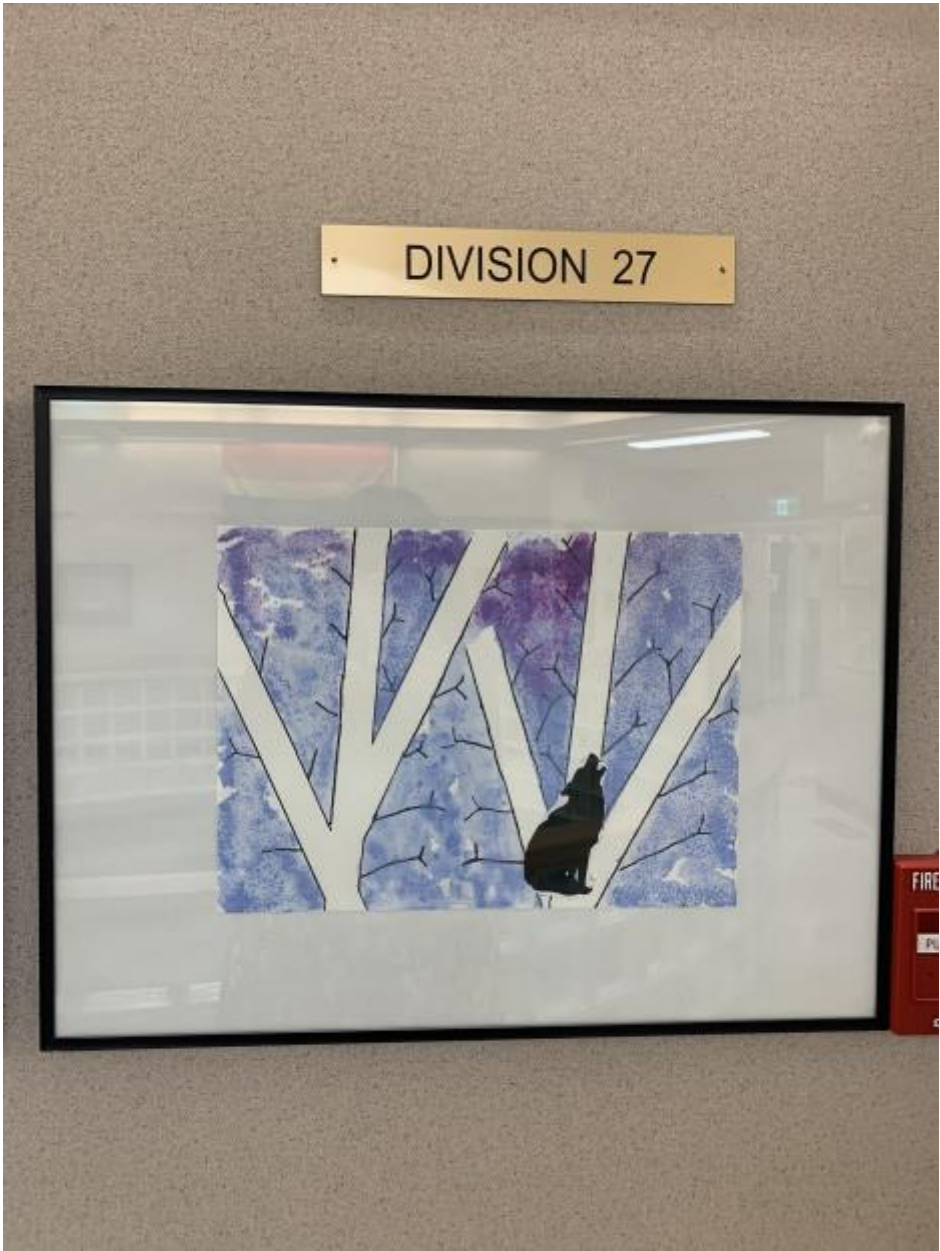


Sacred Circle

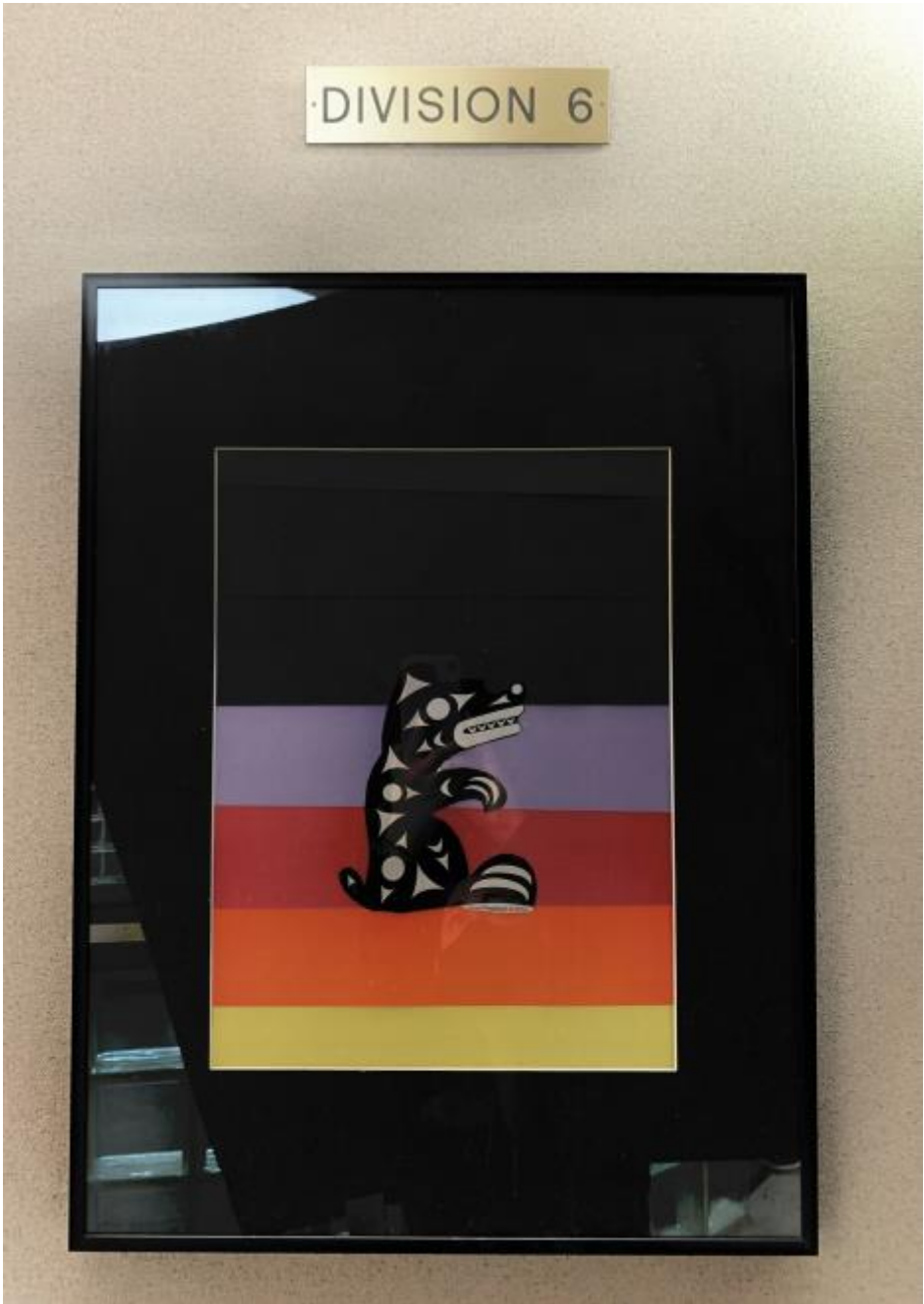

School Cash Online



Frost Road offers *School Cash Online*, which provides you with the convenience, easy, and quick way of paying online for school items such as trips, club/athletic fees, and spirit wear, which is the preferred method of paying for items. *School Cash Online* is a great way to pay without the need for cash or cheques!

Which payment methods are accepted?

Credit Card, Debit Card or eCheck (an electronic version of a paper check used to make payments online. Anyone with a

checking or savings account can pay by **eCheck** on SchoolCashOnline.

myWallet – An online wallet that can be loaded to hold funds and then used to pay for your child’s fees on SchoolCashOnline. myWallet allows you to allocate funds to pay for school fees at a later date. To use myWallet:

Step 1: Visit our school website at: (**www.surreyschools.ca/frostroad**)

Step 2: Click on the “Parent” tab and select “Pay Fees Online”.

Step 3: Register by selecting the “Get Started Now” and follow the steps.

Step 4: After you receive the confirmation email, select the “click here” option, **login in and add each of your children to your household account.**

Once you have registered your child, you will be able to see when they have a new item posted online for purchase. You also have the option to be notified whenever your child has a new school expense due, so you don’t have to worry about missing the deadline.
