7. New Business/Questions

- a. Does the school have a mice problem? The school has an ongoing rodent problem. SD36 has recently changed pest control companies and measures have been taken to reduce the problem.
- b. Is it possible to have one platform for communication with parents? Specifically, athletic parents have raised concerns about lack of communication regarding athletic events and student absences. The MyEd system is the main form of communication as well as the school app. There were suggestions for the coaches to have group chats that include both students and parents.
- c. How much Grad committee roll over funds were left by the 2024 grads for the current 2025 grads and are they matching that? Also are they aware that it is expected that the roll over funds are to be matched, if not surpassed for the next year? The grads of '24 rolled over ~\$10,000 for the current grads. At this point the final numbers for rolling over the deposit funds is unknown although the current grad committee has communicated that they are short on fundraising and have not raised enough to pay forward the same amount. Last projection was possibly only \$5,000 will roll over for the 2026 grads. There was a suggestion for putting the grad roll over funds in a PAC account which would ensure the committee accountability.
