### Principal's Message:

Dear Grandview Heights students and parents,

I hope that this newsletter finds you and your family well and looking forward to the school year ahead. I am delighted to welcome all our new grade 8 students who will be joining us this year. I would also like to extend a special welcome to our Grade 12s, who will be the graduating class of 2027. I hope our students have had a safe and restful summer and that they are looking forward to the upcoming school year.

We have had some changes to our admin team this year and I would like to extend a warm welcome to our new Vice Principal, Arnel Aliwalas who has joined us from North Surrey Secondary.

### Opening Day September 8

All students are required to attend on opening day **September 8**, to confirm their registration. For opening day, students will require a pen and paper. The first day includes an extended homeroom so that teachers can go through specific instructions surrounding our extended day schedule this year. Please ensure you have gone into MyEdBC and accessed your class schedule as these will not be handed out in homeroom. If you have difficulty accessing your schedule, please read the included section "**Accessing your schedule on MyEd**" on the next page of this newsletter.

- **Grade 8 students** will meet for a brief assembly in the large Gym at **10:00 am** where they will be introduced to their Block C homeroom teachers who will escort the students to their homeroom class. In homeroom students will be walked through their schedule and receive any additional material from their homeroom teacher, including **Media Release/Technology Access Forms** that must be filled out by parent/guardians and handed in to the school office.
- **Grades 9, 10, 11 and 12** students will proceed directly to their **Block C Homeroom** class at **12:00 pm**.  
*-Students that do NOT have a Block C class should report to the Learning Commons / Library.*
- Parent/Guardians of all students will be receiving an email, with **Student Information Verification Forms**.  
*- Please fill-out and return to the office if there have been any changes in the information required on the form. If there have been no changes, please disregard the email, as you will not need to return the form.*

Student schedules for the 26/27 school year went live Wednesday August 26, at 4pm. Students are encouraged over the next two weeks to log into MyEd and view their schedule.

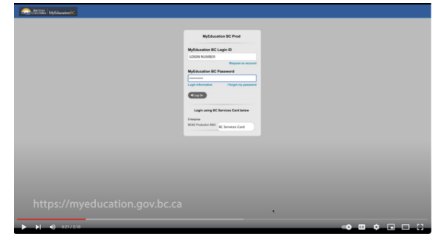
*I am in Grade 8 and I don't know how to login to MYEd to view my schedule.*

*I do not have a username and password and can not access MyEd. How do I get a username and password?*

Answer:

If you are in new to the school our front office will be emailing you within the next week with your user name and temporary password. If you have not received this email by the end of next week, please call the main office and we will address the issue promptly.

If you are a student at Grandview Heights and *can not* remember your username or password, or it is not working, it may need to be reset. Please fill out the [Password Reset Form](#) found on the school website and App or email us at [grandview@surreyschools.ca](mailto:grandview@surreyschools.ca). Please note due to the volume it may take 2-3 days for a response. Do not panic, you will have up until September 15th make changes to your schedule based on criteria for course changes.

### **Grade 11-12 Flex Blocks**

Due to our extended day schedule, most grade 11 & 12's will have flex blocks in their schedule.

During this time, students may exit the building. If they choose to stay at school to work, they are asked to remain in the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Learning Commons or in the Atrium on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor.

### **Growing as Grizzlies**

Over the past few months, we have hired more teachers who are eager to start their work supporting students in their learning this year.

Our student enrolment is still increasing as new families move into our catchment. As many families are aware, our school will be operating on a five-block schedule again this year. We know that this brings opportunities and challenges for many families, and we are here to help in any way we can. The following extended day schedule is as follows:

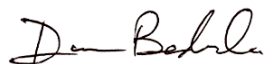
## School Cell Phone Usage

- Please take some time to review your schedule and think carefully about your request before filling out the form. Please know that most course changes will not be possible due to most classes being full. You will need to check MyEd regularly until the end of the first full week of classes to see if changes have been made. Counsellors will not be informing you via Teams. The **form is open until Tuesday, September 15th at 2pm.** All changes will be made by 8am on Wednesday, September 16th. If you are having trouble logging into MyEd, please visit the school website for instructions on how to reset your password: [MyED BC - Instructions.](#)
- **Please do not Teams message, call or email regarding course change requests. Your counsellor will reach out to you via Teams or phone call if they have a question about your Form. We appreciate your support with this as it significantly improves our ability to review the Forms in a timely, equitable and efficient manner.**

## HELPFUL REMINDERS TO NOTE

- Parents & Students, please remember to leave yourself plenty of time to arrive at school - taking in to account for the road construction happening around the school and other issues like the heavy traffic during pickup and drop-off times.
- Students needing their MyEdBC password reset. Please use the link found on the website ([same as the QR code posted in the school](#)). Be aware that this reset is Not Automated and may take a day to be processed. Once your account has been reset, a temporary password will be emailed to your @surreyschools.ca account or your personal email if registered to your account.
- Students needing their Surrey Schools account password reset may ask their home room teacher or visit the office during or after lunch each day when school is in session. Passwords must be at least 20 characters long, with at least 1 each of: a lower case letter, upper case letter, a number and symbol. *This is the account you use to login to the school wifi or teams when it asks.*
- Parents please provide your student with a personal lock to use with the Gym change-room lockers when they are taking physical education. This will help keep everyone's belongings safe and organized. School locks must stay on their assigned hallway locker and can not be used on change-room lockers.
- Registration for school Clubs wishing to run during the 2026/2027 school year will become available during the second week of school.  
--> All clubs must re-apply each year!
- Student parking passes are available from the office throughout the year! They are a bargain at only \$5 for the entire school year. Note: You will be required to prove insurance and drivers license.

**\* Only School Provided Locks are allowed to be used on the hallway lockers. Please DO NOT remove your lockers assigned lock or use it on the gym lockers.**

## PARKING / DROP-OFFS & PICK-UP INSTRUCTIONS

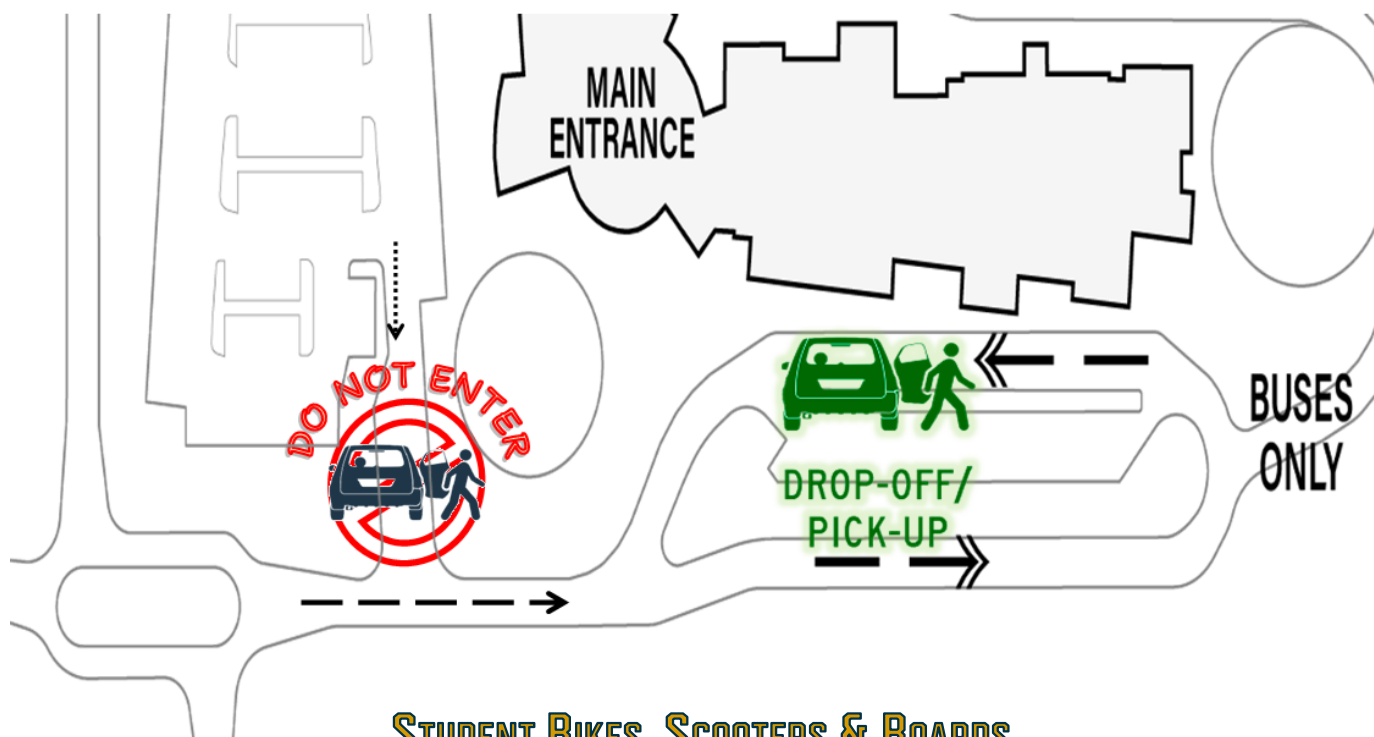
Grandview Heights Secondary Administration, staff and school PAC has worked together with the Surrey School District and City of Surrey to address some of the many traffic and safety concerns in and around our school property. I would like to thank our PACs transportation committee for their leadership and help with our work together. We have included a school traffic flow map and general updates to ensure student and staff safety remains a top priority during the morning drop off and afternoon pick up times. Please review the following information and be sure to adhere to all instructions included in this communication.

The major concerns are regarding the South-West Entrance way that runs along the West side of the Main office and in front of the Theatre. In particular, the congestion that is created when the Visitor Parking and the Accessible Parking spaces are used for the drop-off and pick-up of students is an issue that we would like to bring to everyone's attention. **We ask that vehicles do not pull into, and then out of, the Staff & Student Parking Lot or any Accessible Parking spaces for the purpose of drop-offs or pick-ups.**

**Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up.** For parents dropping off students at school, there are two laneways which run along the South side of the main classroom section of Grandview Heights. Vehicles will need to travel towards the far South-East part of the school property to enter these lanes and turn left to enter these lanes and head West through the laneways. The lane-way furthest to the South has angled visitor parking spaces, while the lane-way North of this is designed for vehicles to pull parallel to the curb to allow for exit and entrance to vehicles by students. **Please be aware that the doors on the East side of the building are available for students to enter the school through in the morning.**

Student Parking – Students parking vehicles on school property are required to park in the North-West section of the parking lot that sits to the West of the Tech-Ed Shops. **A student parking pass may be obtained from the main office.**

**Please always drive carefully and slowly while on school property  
& do not enter or travel through the Bus Lane.**



## STUDENT BIKES, SCOOTERS & BOARDS

**Students and Guardians. Please make sure you have the necessary equipment to secure your personal transportation devices to one of the provided parking racks surrounding the outside of the school. Scooters, Skateboards, Bikes and like devices are not permitted to be stored inside the school as this can create a safety hazard.**

## MEDICAL ALERTS

**Parents/Guardians are responsible to update the school with any medical issues.**

A Medical Alert condition is defined as a physician diagnosed, potentially life threatening condition such as:

- Diabetes.
- Epilepsy.
- Anaphylaxis  
(history of a severe allergic response which requires planned support inside as well as outside the school environment).
- Severe Asthma  
(history of episodes requiring immediate medical treatment or a history of requiring immediate medication).
- Blood clotting disorders such as hemophilia that require immediate medical care in the event of injury.
- Serious heart conditions.
- Other conditions which may require emergency care and/or the administration of medication as determined in consultation with parents/student/family physician, school and Medical Health Officer or designate.

In emergency situations, the parent/guardian or emergency contact shall be contacted.

**As per District policy, we are unable to provide students with any over-the-counter medication (example: Advil, Tylenol).**

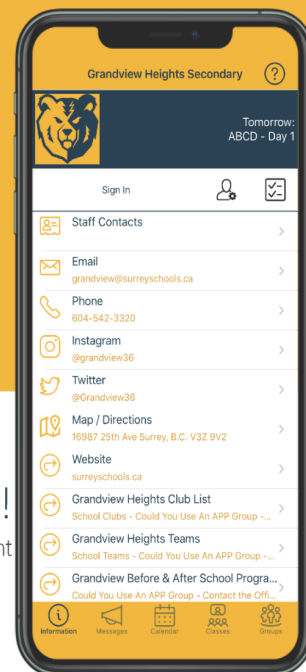
