Principal's Message,

Dear Grandview Heights students and parents,

I hope that this newsletter finds you and your family well and looking forward to the school year ahead. I am delighted to welcome all our new grade 8 students who will be joining us this year. I would also like to extend a special welcome to our Grade 12s, who will be the graduating class of 2025. I hope our students have had a safe and restful summer and that they are looking forward to the upcoming school year.

Opening Day September 3

All students are required to attend on opening day **September 3, 2024** to confirm their registration. For opening day, students will require a pen and paper. The first day includes an extended homeroom so that teachers can go through specific instructions new to our extended day schedule this year. Please ensure you have gone into MYEd and accessed your class schedule as these will not be handed out in homeroom. If you have difficulty accessing your schedule please read *Accessing your schedule in MYEd* this newsletter.

Grade 8 students will meet for a brief assembly in the large Gym at **10:00 am** where they will be introduced to their homeroom teachers who will escort the students to their homeroom class. In homeroom students will be walked through their schedule. Grade 8s are encouraged to access their schedule prior to homeroom on MYEd. If you are unsure how to do this please read **'Accessing your schedule on MYEd' on the next page of this newsletter.**

ACCESSING YOUR SCHEDULE ON MYED

COMMON QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

Our schedule for next year went live Thursday August 22, at 3pm. Students are encouraged over the next two weeks to log into MYEd and view their schedule.

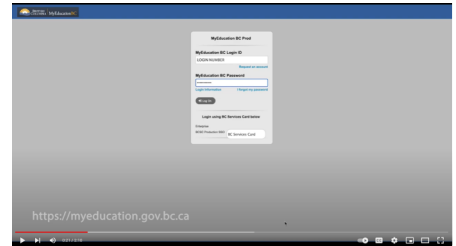
I am in Grade 8 and I don't know how to login to MYEd to view my schedule.

I do not have a username and password and can not access MyEd. How do I get a username and password?

Answer:

If you are new to the school our front office will be emailing you within the next week with your user name and temporary password. If you have not received this email by end of next week please call the main office and we will address the issue promptly.

If you are a student at Grandview Heights and can not remember your username or password, or it is not working it may need to be reset. Please email us at grandview@surreyschools.ca. Please note due to the volume it may take 2-3 days for a response. Please do not panic, you will have up until September 6th to make changes to your schedule based on criteria for course changes.

Grade 12 Flex Blocks

Due to our extended day schedule, most grade 12's will have flex blocks in their schedule.

During this time, students may exit the building. If they choose to stay at school to work, they are asked to remain in the 2nd floor Learning Commons or in the Atrium on the 3rd floor.

Growing as Grizzlies

Over the past few months, we have hired 25 more teachers who are eager to start their work supporting students in their learning this year. This brings our teaching staff to around 85. Our student enrolment is up to 1815 as new families move into our catchment. As many families are aware our school will be operating on a five-block schedule this year. We know that this brings opportunities and challenges for many families, and we are here to help in any way we can. The following extended day schedule is as follows:

MEDICAL ALERTS

Parents/Guardians are responsible to update the school with any medical issues.

A Medical Alert condition is defined as a physician diagnosed, potentially life threatening condition such as:

- Diabetes.
- Epilepsy.
- Anaphylaxis
(history of a severe allergic response which requires planned support inside as well as outside the school environment).
- Severe Asthma
(history of episodes requiring immediate medical treatment or a history of requiring immediate medication).
- Blood clotting disorders such as hemophilia that require immediate medical care in the event of injury.
- Serious heart conditions.
- Other conditions which may require emergency care and/or the administration of medication as determined in consultation with parents/student/family physician, school and Medical Health Officer or designate.

In emergency situations, the parent/guardian or emergency contact shall be contacted.

As per District policy, we are unable to provide students with any over-the-counter medication (example: Advil, Tylenol).

PARKING / DROP-OFFS & PICK-UP INSTRUCTIONS

Grandview Heights Secondary Administration, staff and school PAC has worked together with the Surrey School District and City of Surrey to address some of the many traffic and safety concerns in and around our school property. I would like to thank our PACs transportation committee for their leadership and help with our work together. We have included a school traffic flow map and general updates to ensure student and staff safety remains a top priority during the morning drop off and afternoon pick up times. Please review the following information and be sure to adhere to all instructions included in this communication.

As we head into our third year at Grandview Heights, we would like to address some concerns around our Parking Lots and the Drop-Off and Pick-Up of students.

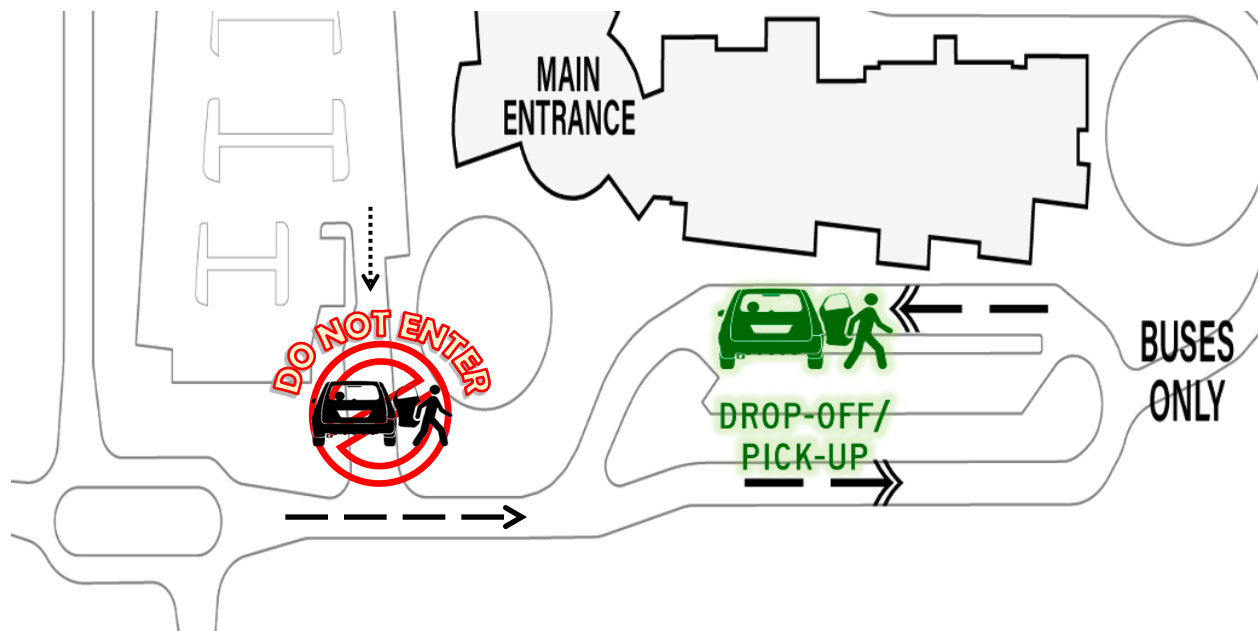
The major concerns are regarding the South-West Entrance way that runs along the West side of the Main office and in front of the Theatre. In particular, the congestion that is created when the Visitor Parking and the Accessible Parking spaces are used for the drop-off and pick-up of students is an issue that we would like to bring to everyone's attention. **As we start this school year, we are asking that vehicles do not pull into, and then out of, the Staff & Student Parking Lot or any Accessible Parking spaces for the purpose of drop-offs or pick-ups.** To address this situation staff members will be near these spaces, at the start of the school year, to remind individuals to use the designated Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up routes. (Please see attached maps)

Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up. For parents dropping off students at school, there are two laneways which run along the South side of the main classroom section of Grandview Heights. Vehicles will need to travel towards the far South-East part of the school property to enter these lanes and turn left to enter these lanes and head West through the laneways. The laneway furthest to the South has angled visitor parking spaces, while the laneway North of this is designed for vehicles to pull parallel to the curb to allow for exit and entrance to vehicles by students. **Please be aware that the doors on the East side of the building are available for students to enter the school through in the morning.**

There will be seven buses that will drop-off and pick-up students each day at Grandview Heights. Buses will drop-off and pick-up students in the back driveway that runs between the gravel field and the basketball court behind the school (North-East of the Main Entrance to the school). **Only Buses and other Designated District vehicles are permitted to use this driveway.**

Student Parking – Students who will be parking vehicles on school property will be required to park in the North-West section of the parking lot that sits to the West of the Tech-Ed Shops. **A student parking pass may be obtained from the main office.**

Please always drive carefully and slowly while on school property and do not enter or travel through the Bus Lane.



BUSING INFORMATION

The following communication is relayed from [District Student Bus Services](#):

All students: Students who apply after the July 15 deadline are not guaranteed a seat on the bus. (Deadline will be reverting to June 30 in 2025-26 and for subsequent school years.) Eligible families can still apply for busing for any seats that may be remaining, however, applications submitted after the July 15 deadline will be processed **beginning September 15**. There will not be any seats available for late Courtesy (fee paying) students.

Families are responsible for transporting their student to and from school, and will need to make alternate transportation arrangements for their student until such time as a seat may be awarded.

Eligible students:

Bus service starts the second day of school and goes according to the pickup and drop off times indicated on the bus schedule. **LATE** Eligible student applications will be advised within five (5) school days **after processing** if their student has been awarded a seat (processing begins September 15).

Courtesy students:

There may be a very limited number of seats available for purchase. Your student may have received a seat in previous years, but may not receive a seat for the current school year. Courtesy students are not guaranteed a seat on the bus since the number of eligible applications vary from year to year. Please ensure you have another source of transportation set up for your students in the event they are not awarded a seat. Only if buses are not at full capacity will there be extra seats available and offered to paying courtesy riders.

If there are seats remaining for Courtesy students that have applied by the July 15 deadline, Transportation will advise the school beginning October 1. (Actual date of registration submission has no bearing on Courtesy seat assignment as long as it meets the deadline. Courtesy students are seated using a complex set of criteria beginning with farthest distance from the school (in-catchment). If seats still remain the criteria broadens.)

The school will then contact the parent / guardian if a seat is available for your student - in which case the school will then collect payment before the student is awarded the seat. Courtesy families will be invoiced a prorated yearly fee of \$30 per full/partial month for the first student (\$15 for siblings) for the remainder of the 2024-25 school year. (Prices are subject to change on an annual basis and are under review for the 2025-26 school year.) Once payment has been made a schedule and bus pass will then be provided. Alternatively, families will be contacted by Transportation **directly** beginning October 1st if there are no seats remaining for your student.

All students must have an authorized and stamped schedule for the 2024-25 school year in order to board the bus, until the printed pass card is received. Students without an authorized schedule will be refused to ride. Students will not be permitted to ride another bus route or board at times other than indicated on their schedule.
