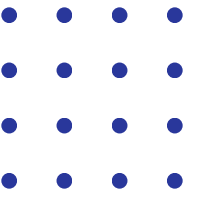
Often a specialized technical or vocational focus.

Difference between certificate, diploma, and degree



<u>Certificate</u>	<u>Diploma</u>	<u>Undergraduate degree</u>
Completion of specific work or training required for a specified area of study or skill.	Practical, hands-on, and specialized training for a specific industry or trade.	Broad, in-depth, and theoretical education, often including general education and specialized coursework.
A few days to 2 years	1 to 2 years	4 years

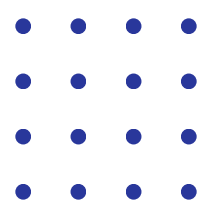
