

IMPORTANT UPDATE REGARDING GRANDVIEW HEIGHTS SECONDARY

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Grandview Heights Secondary, a new state-of-the-art 1,500 student capacity secondary school in the Grandview Heights area of Surrey (16988 25th Ave.), is under construction and is scheduled to open in September 2021. We are excited to see the school coming to life and look forward to greeting our first students and families. Last spring, the School District sent a letter to all parents and guardians outlining the catchment boundaries for Grandview Heights Secondary. The purpose of this letter is to provide all future catchment Grandview Secondary families with an update on the construction progress of Grandview Heights Secondary.

We have included a link to a narrated <u>power point</u> that has designed to provide you with information regarding the construction progress, pictures and design of Grandview Heights, information on the transition plans and also includes a virtual introduction to the new principal, Mr. Bedard. In addition, families can follow the <u>construction</u> <u>progress</u> and <u>virtually tour</u> the new school.

Mr. Bedard continues to be busy behind the scenes and has created a <u>form</u> that will allow families to ask questions about the new school and transition plans.
