Daily Health Check

Daily health check means checking yourself and your child every morning for COVID-19 symptoms.

Stay home when sick or self-isolating.

- Use the [BC Self-Assessment Tool](#), or follow [BCCDC testing guidance](#) (PDF) to know what to do if you are sick.

If you answered “YES” to one of the questions including under ‘Key Symptoms of Illness’ (excluding fever), you

should stay home for 24 hours from when the symptom started. If the symptom improves, you may return to school when you feel well enough. If the symptom persists or worsens, seek a health assessment.

If you answered “YES” to two or more of the questions included under ‘Symptoms of Illness’ or you have a

fever, seek a health assessment. A health assessment includes calling 8-1-1, or a primary care provider. If a health assessment is required, you should not return to school until COVID-19 has been excluded and your symptoms have improved.

February is Kindness Month

Every year we ask the students to do three acts of kindness; one for the community, one for someone close to them and one for themselves.

For the community, classes made valentines cards to send to seniors living in care homes. "Send a Senior some Love" cards were sent to Vancouver, Surrey, Chilliwack, Richmond and Agassiz.

Registration began MONDAY, JANUARY 11th, 2021. Children who will turn five years old before January 1st, 2022 are eligible to begin school in September 2021.
