Thursday, **April 22** is **Earth Day**, and to celebrate, here are some ideas families can do at work and at home to reduce their energy consumption.



Lights off when leaving a room.

Remove the box and reduce gas costs by 15%

- As winter is over you may not need the ski box or rack on the car and if you use if for a couple of weeks of camping, remove when not needed as ski boxes and even just racks can reduce your fuel economy by 11-19% depending on your vehicle style.
- At an average 15% reduction in fuel economy, that is like paying \$1.72 per litre of gas. Put another way, you can reduce your greenhouse gas emission and costs from driving by 15%.

As the weather improves and the temperature warms up, there's no better time to get kids walking and rolling to school. Let's see if we can get the entire school walking, running, riding or rolling into school. Not only is it good for the environment, it helps build healthy hearts!

As the weather gets warmer, please remember to send your child with footwear that is safe for climbing, running and outdoor play. Flipflops are not recommended.
