The Power of Reading with Your Child


Reading with your child fosters literacy, gives you a chance to connect with your child, and helps your child learn about their social and emotional world.

When we read with children, they come to understand the world through the characters. They learn the characters' thoughts, feelings, what drives them, what scares them, what makes them happy.

How does that happen? Dr. Raymond Mat is an expert on this. In 2017 he spoke on our panel about <u>Empathy and the Arts</u> and in 2014 he presented at the <u>Roots of Empathy Research Symposium</u>. <u>Here</u> is a short clip from his symposium presentation.
