Principal Report

- Not much to report

- Computers

- There was some surplus pac money donated to the school during a previous year so that money went towards Zumba and reading link challenge for the students.
- High school may take over music portable next year as the music class will need to move back into the school.

Treasurer Report

- \$500 went towards the scholarship program at Sullivan Heights.
- There might be some left over funds at the end of the year that we might be able to put towards more computers.
- General account has no movement
 - Paid for some water
