Below you will find a timeline and a description of what you can expect at each step along the way. Key choice is centered on Languages, Arts Module and then a Design Module.

Grade 9 Explorations Year

In the Exploration Years (Grade 8 & 9), students are immersed in a semester of Arts Learning and a semester of Design Learning

The **Arts Learning** courses are:

- Humanities (English and Social Studies)
- Languages (Spanish, French or Intensive French)
- Arts Module (Choir, Dance, Art, Drama) or Band

The **Design Learning** courses are:

- Science
- Math
- Physical Health Education
- Design Module (ADST Applied Design, Skills and Technologies)
 - The ADST Module A will include at least two of the following: Woodwork, Metalwork, Foods, Textiles, Information Technology/Web Design, Power Tech
 - The ADST Module B will include at least two of the following: Drafting, Business Ed, Information Technology/Web Design, Robotics, Animation
 - The ADST Module C (Band Students) will include at least two of the following: Drafting, Business Ed, Information Technology/Web Design, Robotics, Animation
