Scholarships and Bursaries at Invergarry Adult Education Centre recognize graduating students for excellence in their chosen area of strength. They are intended to provide recognition and tuition assistance to students pursuing post-secondary education.

I. ELIGIBILITY

- a) Candidates must be in Grade Twelve and must complete graduation requirements by August 31st of the student's graduating year.
- b) Candidates must be intending to continue some form of vocational or academic training within two years of winning any award.
- c) Candidates should have an above-average achievement record, particularly in those courses related to their future vocational plans.
- d) Must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident (landed immigrant) at the time of application.
- e) Candidates awarded a Scholarship or Bursary must provide (from a Post-Secondary Institution) proof of registration in order to receive the awarded amount.

II. SELECTION OF AWARD WINNERS

The selection of winning candidates is made by the school's Scholarship and Bursary Committee. Factors used in selecting winners may include:

1. School achievement record and attendance
2. Community and school involvement
3. Post-secondary plans
4. Financial need
