SCHOLARSHIP NEWS

- ▶ There are 2 types of in-school scholarships. Students can apply for just one type, or both.
 - ▶ **In School Scholarships** – dozens of awards with various criteria including academics, volunteer experience, athletics, citizenship and more.
 - ▶ **District Authority Awards** – students must submit a digital portfolio to show expertise or skills in one of the following areas:
 - ▶ Music, Dance, Visual Arts, Dance, Home Economics, Tech Ed, Business & IT, Physical Activity, Community Service, Trades, Second Language, or Indigenous Language & Culture
 - ▶ Students may apply in more than one area. Each area requires a separate application and portfolio.
