

Certification of Graduation (Dogwood)

USE:

A Dogwood is conferred on students who have met all graduation requirements successfully. It indicates that a student has achieved the provincial learning outcomes set out by the Ministry of Education.

PROCESS:

A student will pursue a Dogwood so long as their

REQUIREMENTS:

Planning 10

Language Arts 10, Language Art 11, Language Arts 12

Mathematics 10, Mathematics 11 *or* 12

Fine Arts *and/or* Applied Skills 10, 11, *or* 12

Social Studies 10, Social Studies 11, *or* Social Studies 12

Science 10, Science 11, *or* Science 12

Physical Education 10

7 other elective courses

Adult Graduation Diploma (Adult Dogwood)

USE:

An Adult Dogwood enables adult learners (18 or over) to receive a graduation certificate **EQUIVALENT** to a Dogwood.

PROCESS:

A student can only be placed on an Adult Graduation program **AFTER** the age of 18.

REQUIREMENTS:

ONE Language Arts 12 course

ONE Mathematics 11 or 12 course

(*THREE* Grade 12 Ministry-authorized courses

or

Social Studies 11 and *TWO* Grade 12 Ministry-authorized courses)

THREE courses must be completed after being enrolled in the program. *TWO* courses taken before the student turned 18 can be used.

School Completion Certificate (Evergreen)

USE:

An Evergreen recognizes that an individual has successfully completed **PERSONAL** goals of their educational program, other than graduation.

A student receiving an Evergreen has not graduated.

PROCESS:

A student should not be placed on an Evergreen program prior to Grade 10 and should be done with the informed consent of a parent/guardian.

REQUIREMENTS:

An Evergreen can be achieved by a student for meeting the educational goals set out in their Individual Education Plan (IEP).
