The graduation events at Earl Marriott are intended to build community among the members of the **Class of 2025** and to contribute to the development of positive school culture and traditions. It is very important that we remind parents and grads that **all events organized and sponsored by the school must be alcohol and drug free.** Everyone should understand that this is for the safety of students. Students and guests must behave appropriately and act with good judgement at all times.

### **Commencement Ceremony**

The Commencement Ceremony will be held at 7:00pm on Wednesday, May 21, 2025, at the Chandos Pattison Auditorium (@ Pacific Academy, 10238 – 168<sup>th</sup> Street, Surrey). *Grads are asked to arrive at 6:15 for the Processional line up.* 

Graduates will receive 3 **free tickets, which will be distributed on April 28**<sup>th</sup> **in C block**. Please return any tickets that will not be used to Ms. McLean in the office. Remaining tickets will be available for sale on a first come, first served basis (limit 1 per graduate, at first) at a cost of \$5.00. This online option will be available May 5-9<sup>th</sup> and these additional tickets will be distributed May 13<sup>th</sup> in the office. All guests, including children must have a ticket and this ticket must be presented at the door for admission. Graduates do not require tickets. At this time, any further remaining tickets will be available for purchase on May 15<sup>th</sup> in the office at lunch.

Please note—Grads will not be issued commencement tickets unless all grad fees, school fees, outstanding textbook charges are paid.

### **Grad Gowns and Rehearsal**

On the morning of May 20<sup>th</sup>, grads will receive their grad gowns beginning @9:00 am. They will then change into their gown in preparation for their grad walk through. At 9:45 am students will prepare to board busses for a 10:00 am departure. They will proceed to do a walkabout at their elementary school along with one other school. There will be a mandatory rehearsal and assembly for all grads on Tuesday, May 20, Block A, in the main gym. Gowns are for grads to keep. Do not iron the gown. Grads are to arrive at Commencement wearing their cap and gown. Dress for the ceremony is semi-formal with appropriate footwear to be seen below the gown length. Remember, purses and cell phones are to be left with grads' families or at home as there will be no storage location and these items are not permitted on stage. **EMS is not responsible for lost or stolen items.** 

### **Grad Dinner/Dance and Family Celebration – June 21, 2025**

There will be a Family Celebration at the school prior to the Grad Banquet on Saturday, June 21. Students will arrive at the school by 4:00pm. A stand-up reception for parents and extended family will follow with light refreshments, coffee and tea. It will be an opportunity for families to take pictures with graduates and their friends against beautiful backdrops at the school. Tickets for parents/family members will cost \$10 per person and can be purchased through School Cash Online (https://surreyschools.schoolcashonline.com/).

Bus transportation to Tsawwassen Springs is mandatory for all grads (and approved guests). Grads must check in and be screened through security by 5:00 pm at the school. Failure to do so will result in grads being denied entry into the grad Dinner/Dance. There are no private cars or limousines to Tsawwassen Springs.

At 5:30 pm, grads will depart the school by coach bus to be transported to Tsawwassen Springs for the Grad Dinner/Dance.

Tickets for the Dinner/Dance (includes transportation, dinner, DJ and Grad group photo) can be purchased through School Cash Online May 5-23<sup>rd</sup> (https://surreyschools.schoolcashonline.com/). **Tickets are non-refundable.** Please elect a table captain who will complete the table seating form included in this package and submit **for all of the grads at that table**. Once students have paid online, they may submit one order form for each table. Please notify Ms. McLean in the office if you have any dietary restrictions.

### Table Seating forms are due to Ms. McLean by June 2, 2025.

Smaller groups will be combined into one table.

Grads, their guests, and parents are reminded that this is a school sponsored event. Upon entry, there will be a security check of bags and purses. Anyone under the influence or in possession of drugs or alcohol will not be allowed entrance to the Family Celebration or Grad Dinner/Dance. In addition, there is no smoking for any grads or guests during the duration of the event as there will be no in/out privileges for anyone attending the Family Celebration and Dinner/Dance.

Grads and their guests will be required to drop off their change of clothes for the Dry Grad to the school on Friday, June 20 in the box gym from 3:30-6:00 pm. All bags will be checked by security at this time. Bringing bags to the grad Family Celebration/Dinner/Dance will not be permitted, nor will storing bags in parent vehicles. Bags will be transported securely from the school to the Dry Grad event and grads will change at Dry Grad. All grads and guests will be required to be transported to the Dry Grad event by bus.

The Dry Grad Event will follow the Graduation Dinner/Dance on Saturday/Sunday, June 21/22, 2025, from 11:00 pm to 4:00 am. It will be held at the South Surrey Recreation Center. This is a school-supported event, however it is organized directly by our Grad parents. **We need volunteers.** If you would like to remain in the loop with regards to Dry Grad fundraising, events, planning, and volunteer opportunities, please email <a href="mailto:emsdrygrad2025@gmail.com">emsdrygrad2025@gmail.com</a> indicating you would like to be added to the dry grad email list.

#### Here are the details:

- Saturday, June 21<sup>st</sup> following the school organized dinner/dance taking place at Tsawwassen Springs, the Dry Grad evening activities will begin.
- Those purchasing a ticket for the Dry Grad event will board buses at 10:30 pm from Tsawwassen Springs and be transported back to the South Surrey Recreation Center for an evening full of fun and games. Those not attending Dry Grad will be released at Tsawwassen Springs after the Dinner/Dance. They will need to find their own ride home.
- The Dry Grad event will run from 11:00 pm on Saturday, June 21st to approximately 4:00 am on Sunday, June 22nd.
- Two large gyms will house oversized inflatable activities for the grads to enjoy.
- Another large gym will house a casino room where grads can try their hand at poker, roulette, and blackjack.
- Games, food, a DJ, a magician, caricature artists and a photo booth are just a few other entertainment options available throughout the evening.
- Grads will be able to enter to win raffle prizes (winners will be drawn at the end of the event).
- Parents will pick up grads from the South Surrey Recreation Centre on Sunday June 22<sup>nd</sup> at approximately 4:00 am.

Students attending the dry grad must ride on the buses from the Dinner/Dance event to the South Surrey Recreation Center. Parents of students who have purchased Dry Grad tickets but who do not enter the dry grad event will be called. The order for Dry Grad tickets will also be included on the individual ticket form. Ticket price is \$55 (early bird) each for student and approved guest. After May 30<sup>th</sup> each ticket will be \$65.

### NOTE:

Separate tickets need to be purchased for the Dinner/Dance and Dry Grad. In order for Grads to attend Dry Grad, students MUST also attend the Dinner/Dance.
