- > 1 Math (5 options)
- > 1 Science (7 Options)
- Language 11 (4 Options if planning for Post Secondary)
- > 4 Electives (could be more sciences, or socials or fine arts etc.)
- Numeracy assessment if not already done
- No study blocks

Minimum 8 courses

Grade 12

Graduation Requirements Only

- English 12
- Career Life Connections 12 (which includes the Capstone project)
- > A minimum of 2 additional grade 12 courses
- Electives to complete required number of credits
- Literacy 12 assessment starting 2022

Minimum total of required credits for grades 10-12 is 80 Each course completed counts 4 credits


French Immersion Students

- Grade 10: Sciences 10, Sciences Humaines 10, Francais Langue 10, Education Physique 10, a Math 10, an English 10, CLE 10
- Grade 11: Histoire du Monde 12, Communication Orale 11, a Math 11, an English 11, a Science 11
- ► Grade 12: Francais Langue 12, English Studies 12, CLC 12

Languages

- Please note: this is <u>NOT</u> a graduation requirement
- A language 11 IS a requirement for university entrance (and in some cases a grade 12 language is recommended)



Language Challenge Exam

- An exam done in January at the Delta School District (registration end of October/early November)
- Must have documentation of prior learning
- Can be used as a grade 12 course for graduation and as an entrance course for some universities (NOT for UBC)
- Satisfies the language requirement for all universities



Courses that Require Applications (usually due by March - check individual applications)

- > All Co-op Programs (grade 11)
- > All Career Prep Programs (grades 11 & 12)
- > Peer Tutoring (grades 11 & 12)
- Library Science (grades 11 & 12)
- > Yearbook (grades 11 & 12)
- > Theatre Company (audition grades 11 & 12)

University Degree rule of Thumb 5 (SFU) or 6 (UBC) grade 12 courses

Arts: English 11, Language 11, Science 11, Math 11 (Pre-Cal or Foundations) English 12, (Language 12 recommended for UBC)

Science: English 11, Language 11, Physics and Chem 11, Pre-Cal 11

English 12, Pre-Cal 12, and two of Bio 12, Chem 12, or Physics 12 plus other Grade 12 courses

Business: English 11, Language 11, Pre-Cal 11, Science 11

English 12, Pre-Cal 12 plus other academic Grade 12 courses

(Calculus recommended)

Applied Science (Engineering): English 11, Language 11, Pre-calc 11, Physics 11, Chem 11, English 12, Pre-Calc 12, Physics 12, Chem 12, Calculus 12 (required by some and recommended for others)

Nursing: Requirements vary - please check individual institutions
