






- Personal Education Number (PEN)
- The ability to pay an application fee (by credit card)
- Order transcripts online from <u>www.StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca</u>
- Accurate knowledge of marks for self-reporting

- Artona will provide a copy of the composite and diploma folder at Commencement




Commencement (tentative)
