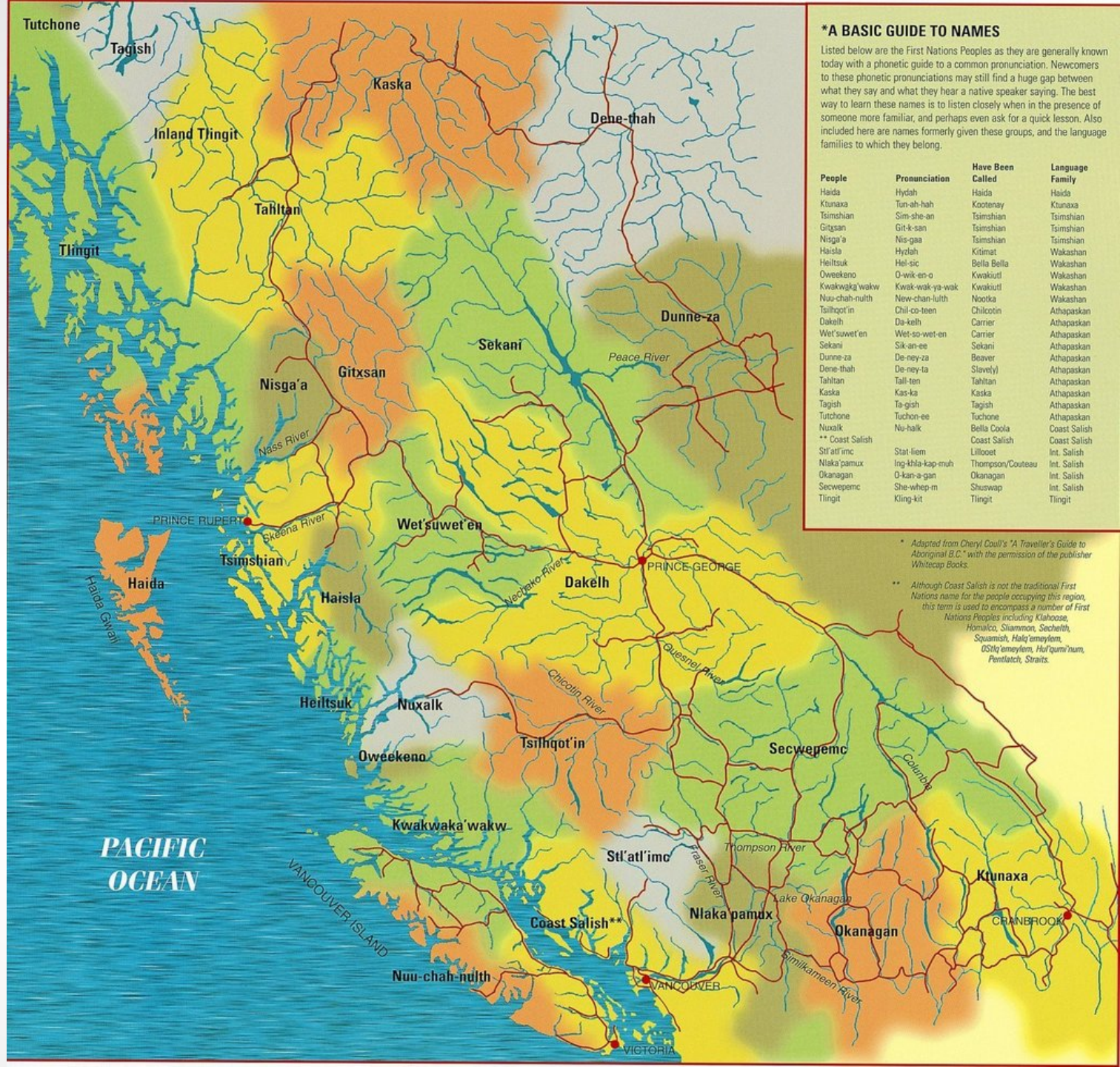

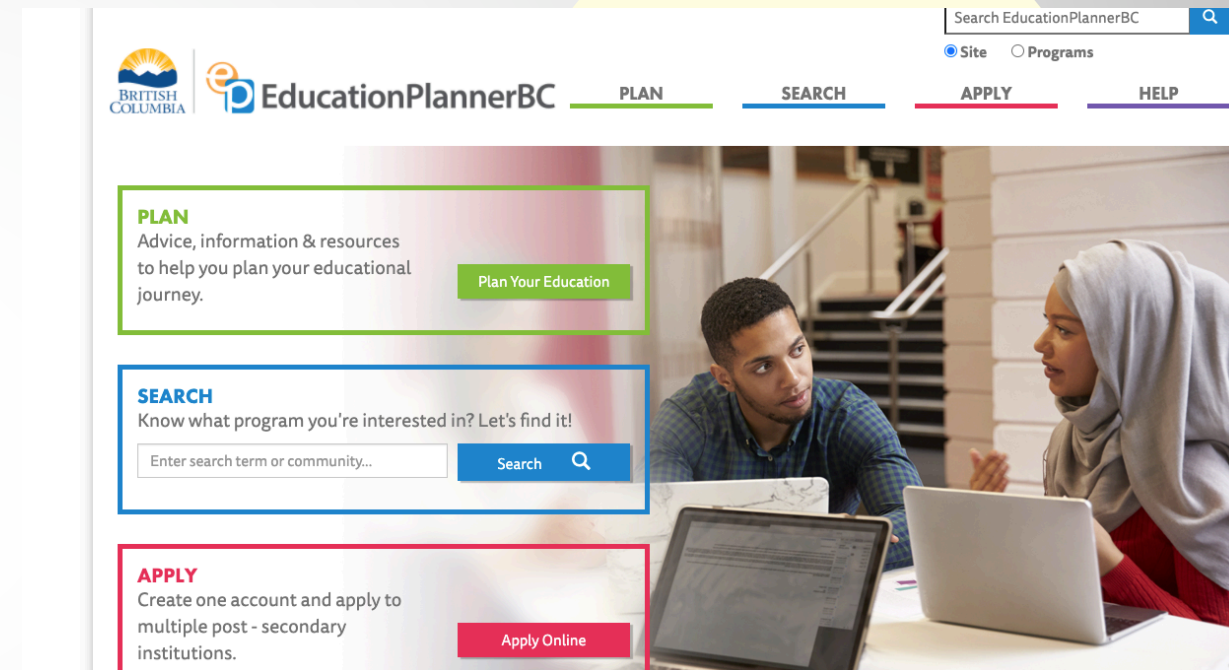

Most Post-Secondary schools' Fall 2022 applications opened on Oct. 1, 2021

What students need to apply:

- Personal Education Number (PEN)
- The ability to pay an application fee (by credit card)
- Order transcripts online from www.StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca
- Accurate knowledge of marks for self-reporting

- ▶ Tickets and gowns will be distributed during a rehearsal assembly (Monday June 6th @ 2.00 pm)



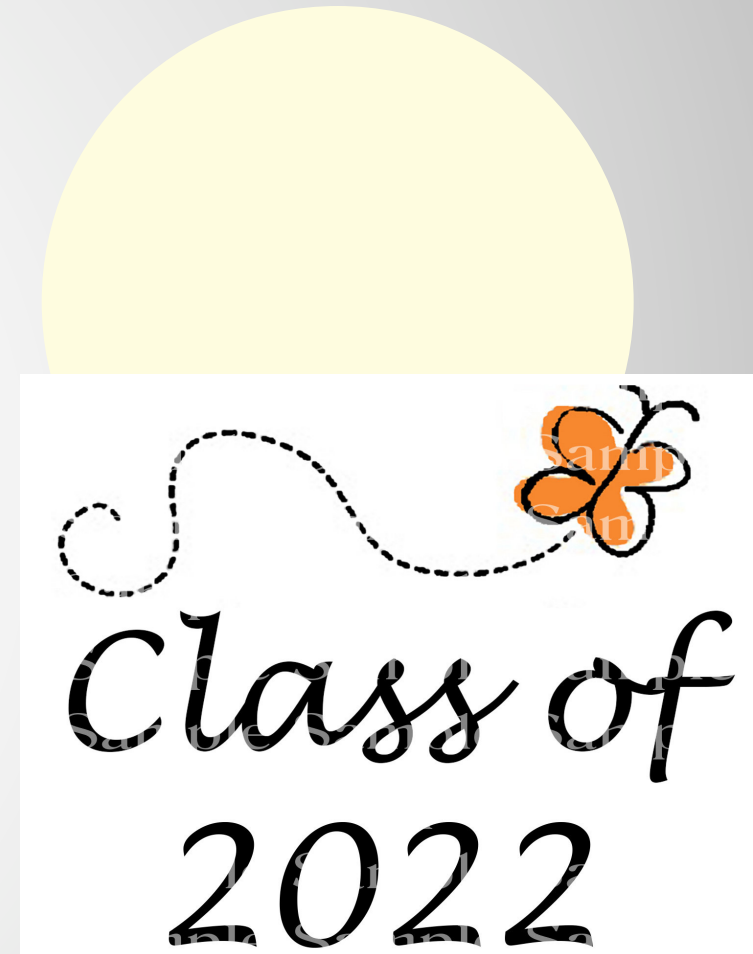
Grad Dinner & Dance
