



Languages: At the grade 9 level, languages are an elective choice. Students can choose to continue with study in French or can begin Spanish with permission from the Languages department. Students can also choose more than one language choice. Some post-secondary programs require more than one language. Arts: Music 9: Jazz Band is scheduled outside the regular school day (either before or after school) and, if selected, is scheduled as a 9th hour class. There is a limit of 15 students per class.
