Graduation and Post-Secondary Application Information



Graduation Credits

- 80 Credits required over 3 years (4 credits per class)
- Checking Grad Status – Nov. 2020
 - Students will review their Transcript Verification Report (TVR) and will need to contact their Alpha counsellor if there are concerns.
- Courses Taken Elsewhere
 - Online - Make sure it's on your TVR! (For example, if a student has taken an on-line course through SAIL or the E-Bus academy, it is their responsibility to make sure the course is on their TVR).
- External Credits
 - Please contact your Alpha counsellor if you wish to determine eligibility for extra credit, Eg: Driver's Educ., Life Saving
- Provincial Assessments
 - The numeracy assessment is a requirement for graduation. The TVR will indicate successful completion of this assessment. If your son or daughter has not completed the assessment, please contact Mr. Kelly.


- Applications to post-secondary institutions open October 1
