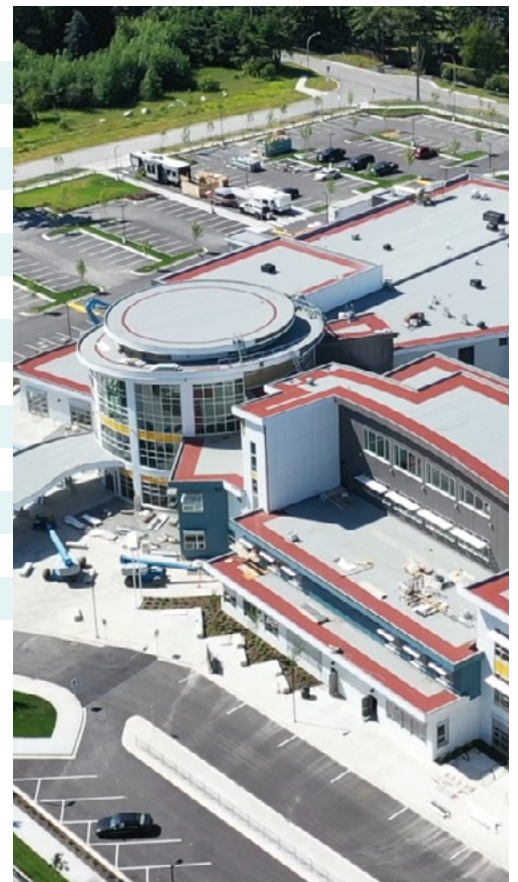


GRANDVIEW HEIGHTS SECONDARY FACT SHEET

Grandview Heights Secondary is a brand new secondary school in South Surrey featuring a state-of-the-art design, opening with a three-storey multipurpose atrium that also serves as a learning commons for students. Throughout the halls of the school, students and staff can make use of learning studios, breakout rooms and collaboration spaces, in addition to science, lifestyles and computer labs.

The school boasts modern shop facilities and two gymnasiums as well as a fitness room and weight room for physical and health education. For arts, students of a variety of talents have use of the school's theatre, dance studio, and music and band room.

Architecturally, the school's design is environmentally conscious, offering a 50% reduction in energy use as compared to a LEED Gold Baseline.
