State of the Art School, Facility and Learning Environment

Grandview Heights Secondary is located at 16987 25 Avenue and at this time is about 65% built. Anyone who has walked or driven by the site will surely be impressed by its magnificent design and layout. The school is designed around what we know about student learning and has incorporated innovative learning spaces, break-out and collaboration rooms, where students can utilize modern, flexible and inclusive environments for personalized and inquiry-based learning. Among many other unique features, the school encompasses a state-of-the-art theater, visual and performing art and dance studios, advanced applied design and technology spaces that will focus on robotics, engineering, electronics, and wood and metal design. Grandview Heights will also have a large and small gymnasium, weight room, fitness room and a full-size outdoor playing field and separate practice field, all surrounded by beautiful grounds. Our gorgeous Atrium will house our learning commons and includes open and flexible space on the third floor for students to utilize.



Grandview Heights Secondary is a part of the larger surrounding community that is rich in culture and diversity. 


Our Timeline to Opening.
