**FIRST WEST FOUNDATION**

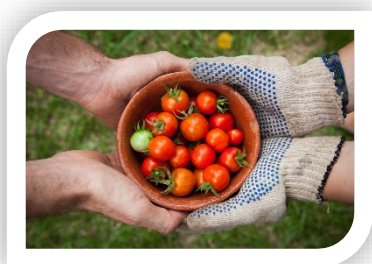
**\$20,000** towards our Triumph over Trauma program. The program provides a creative outlet for 280 refugee youth to express emotions, thoughts and feelings through the mediums of art, supporting students and families to share and address past traumas that they may struggle to express through language.

**\$1,500** donation was made to the Surrey School District's Balancing Minds Conference for youth. The conference focuses on the mental wellness of secondary students and will be held at the Bell Performing Arts Centre on May 7, 2019.

**\$20,000** The After School Sport and Arts initiative (ASSAI) have donated to the Creative U and PLAY on after school programs. The funding will support activities that increase accessibility and inclusion of children with disabilities. Play On and Creative U provide a unique programming opportunity for participants with disabilities.
