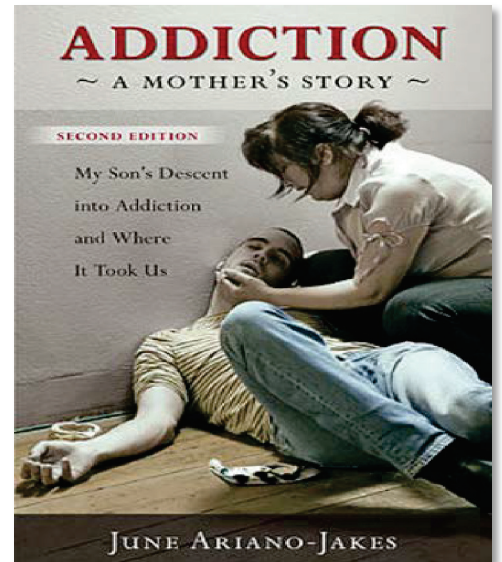

June Ariano-Jakes has volunteered more than twelve thousand hours, spending on average 200 hours a month working and volunteering her time helping those who live in poverty, who are homeless, and who struggle with severe alcoholism, hard-core drug addiction, and mental illness. She is a fierce and loyal advocate for those suffering and is well respected among her peers and those she serves.

Once addiction grabbed hold of her son Nathan, June became relentless in her efforts to understand and educate herself in all areas of addiction as she searched for answers to help her son battle what would become a 23 year heroin and cocaine addiction. June is a much sought after speaker and educator in the field of addiction.
