Dear Parents / Guardians;

We would like to take this opportunity to thank our Georges Vanier community for your patience and understanding as our team has worked to provide a safe and welcoming return to school for the 2020/2021 school year.

You are receiving this letter because you have selected full face to face instruction for your child for the upcoming school year. Our team of dedicated teachers, EA's/ABA's and support staff have all worked tirelessly over the last few days to set up a safe physical space in our school while preparing the safety orientations your child received this week. If you have not already done so, please debrief with your child on what they have learned and help them understand that we are all in this together. It takes a village to raise a child, and please know that the Georges Vanier staff care very much for your child(ren) and we will continue to do everything we can to ensure they feel safe and cared for while at school.

As students leave their orientation session today, teachers will be working to finalize classes and learning cohorts for the upcoming school year. Our staff is thoughtful and purposeful about this process in our efforts to create engaging and supportive learning environments that also meet the new expectations set out by the Ministry of Education. Teachers will continue to collaborate on this process until the end of the day today.

The Surrey School District has established a staggered start time on **Monday**, **September 14**th for students who are returning to full time face to face instruction. Please note the staggered start times for Monday only:

Grades 1 - 3

8:30am until 2:30pm

Kindergarten

All families have received a notice about next week's schedule

Grades 4 - 7

9:00 am until 2:30 pm

On Monday, students in the grade 1-7 face to face instructional program will be formally assigned to their new class and will also join a **learning cohort**. Please look for your child's grade level balloon and students can line up safely by each cone. Teachers will call students from each class and safely walk into the school. The timeline for this process has been expedited in order to follow the Health and Safety protocols during Covid-19.

Starting September 15, grades 1-7 will line up outside at our welcome bell at 8:25am. Instruction will begin at 8:30 am. Please note, our bell schedule has changed slightly from last year.

On Monday, students are reminded to bring a recess snack, a lunch, and a water bottle. Students can also start bringing school supplies in on Monday. If students have ordered school supplies to be picked up at the school; they will be distributed throughout the week.

Before students come to school each day, we require parents/guardians to do a daily health check with your child(ren). We have attached a copy of this daily health check for your reference and we thank all families for doing their part to keep all students and staff safe at school.
