I am proud of our dedicated teaching staff, who have done an amazing job creating welcoming learning environments. We've also been given an extra division, which allows us to better support our students.


We're excited to welcome our new Kindergarten/Grade 1 teacher, Ms. Walia. At this time, no student moves will be made.


Planners are \$5 per student. Please login to School Cash Online to pay this fee.
