- ★ Hot Lunches are provided by pre-order. There is no guarantee of same day concession sales. We order according to the numbers in our system and we do our best to avoid waste and extra cost to the school by only ordering what we need.

VOLUNTEERS

Parents will be needed to hand out lunches to the children's classes on hot lunch days. Information on dates and timing will be distributed through your Class Parent.

We are also in need of more volunteers to take the lead on certain distribution days in the kitchen prior to lunch deliver.


All Hot Lunch volunteers must be double vaccinated.

ORDERING/REGISTRATION

Parents will place their hot lunch orders <u>online</u> using <u>MunchaLunch.com</u>! You can pay for your orders online by credit card (Visa/Mastercard)

- 2) Click the "Register Here" button (as shown below). The system will guide you through
- 3) After adding your children, click the green "Order Lunch!" button to order
- 4) Next time, just click the "Login Here" button to access your account.

MENU SUMMARY
