Snokomish Elementary Boundaries Information Package



Snokomish Elementary is under construction in the Sullivan Heights area of Surrey (14778 58B Ave.). Opening in May 2026, Snokomish Elementary will address the overcrowding at nearby Cambridge, Goldstone Park, Sullivan and École Woodward Hill elementary schools, which collectively are more than 580 students over capacity in a rapidly growing area. Enrolment will continue to grow at neighbourhood schools as development increases.

To prepare for the opening of Snokomish Elementary, new catchment boundaries need to be established to balance student capacity between Snokomish and neighbourhood schools. The district is considering four options for the future of Snokomish, including a recommended option.

To prepare for the school year, students, staff, parents and community members are invited to provide feedback on the options and share their thoughts on the new catchment boundaries for Snokomish Elementary.

How can you be involved?

Surrey Schools believes parent and student input and priorities for catchment boundary moves are an important part of this process. Please review the information regarding the move options in this package. Further information can be found on surreyschools.ca/consultations

We encourage parents and students to provide feedback by completing the survey on the consultation website (survey launches **May 9, 2024**). The consultation period runs until **June 9, 2024**.

In addition, a series of in-person open houses will be held for the district to share information about the potential boundary changes. Each open house runs from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m.:

- May 15 at Cambridge Elementary (6115 150th St.)
- May 22 at Goldstone Park Elementary (6287 146th St.)
- May 28 at Sullivan Elementary (6016 152nd St.)
- May 29 at École Woodward Hill Elementary (6082 142nd St.)

Introducing the options

of the school.

All four options presented in this package aim to establish a new catchment and balance enrolment.

In preparing these options, the school district was guided by the Surrey Board of Education policy, specifically, *Policy* 9200: School Catchment Areas, and *Policy* 9320: Registration and Placement of Students.

- Option 1: Cambridge (59th Ave.) & Goldstone Park to Snokomish, <u>NO</u> French Immersion Move

 Students in the Cambridge (south of 59th Ave.) and Goldstone Park (south of 60th Ave., east of 144th St.) catchments would attend Snokomish Elementary. This would be an immediate move for K-6 students upon opening of the school.
- Option 2: Cambridge (58th Ave.), École Woodward Hill (60th Ave.) & Goldstone Park to Snokomish, <u>NO</u>
 French Immersion Move

Students in the Cambridge (south of 58th Ave.), Woodward Hill and Goldstone Park (south of 60th Ave.) catchments would attend Snokomish Elementary. This would be an immediate move for K-6 students upon opening of the school.

- Option 3 Recommended: Cambridge (58th Ave.), Goldstone Park & Sullivan to Snokomish, with FI Move Students in the Cambridge (south of 58th Ave.), Goldstone Park (south of 60th Ave., east of 144th St.) and Sullivan (north of 54th Ave., west of approximately 149th St.) catchments would attend Snokomish Elementary. French Immersion students would also attend Snokomish. These would be immediate moves for K-6 students upon opening
- Option 4: Cambridge (58th & 58A Ave.), Goldstone Park & Sullivan to Snokomish, with FI Move


Students in the Cambridge (south of the line between 58th and 58A Ave.), Goldstone Park (south of 60th Ave., east of 144th St.) and Sullivan (north of 54th Ave., west of approximately 149th St.) catchments would attend Snokomish Elementary. French Immersion students would also attend Snokomish. These would be immediate moves for K-6 students upon opening of the school.
