#### Important Information

- The Literacy Assessment is a graduation requirement for all students. Part A consists of 16 multiple-choice questions and response questions. During Part B, students will select one of two topics and again respond to a series of multiple choice and longer response questions.
- Results will be reported using a proficiency scale rather than an actual letter grade. Students can re-take the assessment to improve their proficiency. Their best level achieved will be counted as their final mark.
