The British Columbia School Superintendents Association Grade 12 Scholarships

Exemplary Service and Leadership within the school and community

Applications must include the following...

- A completed application form
- 2 Letters of Reference

Scholarship worth \$1,000!

- Short description (450 words max) of how your volunteer service has made a difference in the lives of others
- Demonstrate exemplary service and leadership
- Copy of your official school transcript of your grades to date
- Proof of application/entry to post-secondary school

BC Excellence Scholarship

- \$5,000 scholarship awarded to 55 students throughout BC
- A Resume, 2 Reference Letters (community and school) and a written statement (500 words) are part of the application
- Only 1 nominee per school -> Submit your sample application to the Career Centre by Friday, January 28th, 2022 by 4:00pm to be considered as North Surrey Secondary's nominee

BC Excellence Scholarship

- Basic Eligibility requirements:
 - Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident
 - Be a BC resident
 - Be enrolled in a BC public school
 - Be graduating in the same year the scholarship is awarded (by August 31st)
 - Have no more than one Transfer Standing (TS) or Standing Granted (SG) reported among course marks used to satisfy graduation requirements
 - Have 73% (B) or above in English/Language Arts 12 course

Gloria Barron Prize for Young Heroes



\$10,000 award

Eligibility

The Barron Prize welcomes applications from public-spirited young people who are, on our **April 15** deadline:

- Between the ages of 8 and 18 (not yet age 19)
- Permanent residents of and currently residing in the U.S.A. or Canada
- Currently working on an inspiring service project or have done so within the past 12 months
- Working as an individual to lead their service work. The Barron Prize does not accept applications from large groups of young people.

Clean Energy BC Secondary School Student Scholarship



Eligibility

Must be a BC secondary school student (full-time, currently enrolled) that is graduating in 2022 interested in pursuing a future in clean energy at a post-secondary institution.

1. Applicants must submit a 1-2 page paper in pdf format (approximately 500 words) responding to the following question:

"Why is clean energy important to me as a young person in BC?"
Please cite relevant experience with school projects or volunteer/community work and indicate any career or academic aspirations related to clean energy.

2. Applicants must provide **one** letter of reference. This could be from a teacher, employer, community representative, or coach. The reference letter should speak to your character and work habits.

Kin Canada Bursaries

Eligibility

- Must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident.
- Must be a full-time student in the process of graduating from high school or currently studying or registered at a post-secondary institution.
- Must complete the current application form and submit it to the Kinsmen, Kinette or Kin Club closest to their permanent residence by February 1. Bursary winners are notified before June 30 by their sponsoring club.
- Must not have previously been awarded a Kin Canada Bursary.
- Will be evaluated on their community and school involvement, knowledge of Kin Canada and financial need.

STACEY LEVITT AWARD

The Stacey Levitt Memorial Award was created in memory and celebration of Stacey's life by her family through Parachute.

This award encourages Canadian youth to embody Stacey's qualities and ideals and Parachute's overarching goals of a long life lived to the fullest, understanding the importance of risk management and injury prevention.

Applications close at end of February and the Levitt family awards each year's selected recipient **\$2,500** to help them live their life to the fullest. The award could be put toward:

Ted Rogers Scholarship Fund For Indigenous Students

The Ted Rogers Scholarship through Indspire is for Canadian Indigenous students starting a post-secondary program in the fall of 2022. It is a renewable award of \$2500 per year for students enrolled in a minimum two year post-secondary program to a maximum of four years. While enrolled in post-secondary students must maintain a full-time course load to receive the renewed support each year.

Requirements:

- Students must be entering into full time studies in a first bachelor degree or first diploma program at a Canadian accredited university or college.
- Program must be a minimum of 2 years in duration.
- University preparatory programs in any jurisdiction are not eligible
- Students must be under the age of 29 and a Canadian citizen and have a valid social insurance number.



SCHOLARSHIPS & AWARDS

Douglas College Entrance Scholarship and Award program offers a variety of one-time awards of up to \$3,500, and renewable awards of up to \$20,000, payable over four years.

- Entrance Scholarships: Students must have a minimum admission GPA of 3.5 and significant contributions to their school or community.
- Entrance Awards: Students must have a minimum admission GPA of 3.0 and significant contributions to their school or community.

Completed applications must be received by Douglas College by March 1, 2022 4:00pm.

All applicants who submit an Entrance Scholarship & Award application for the 2022/2023 academic year will be notified of Douglas College's decision by **April 15**, **2022**.
